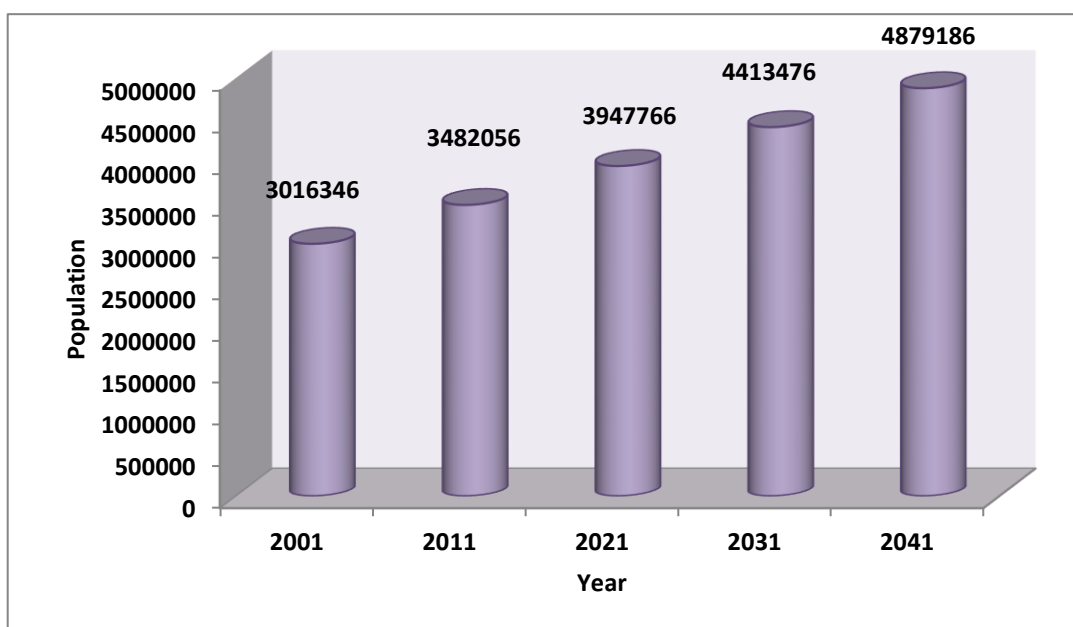


Fig .1.Forecasting Population for 2021-2041
