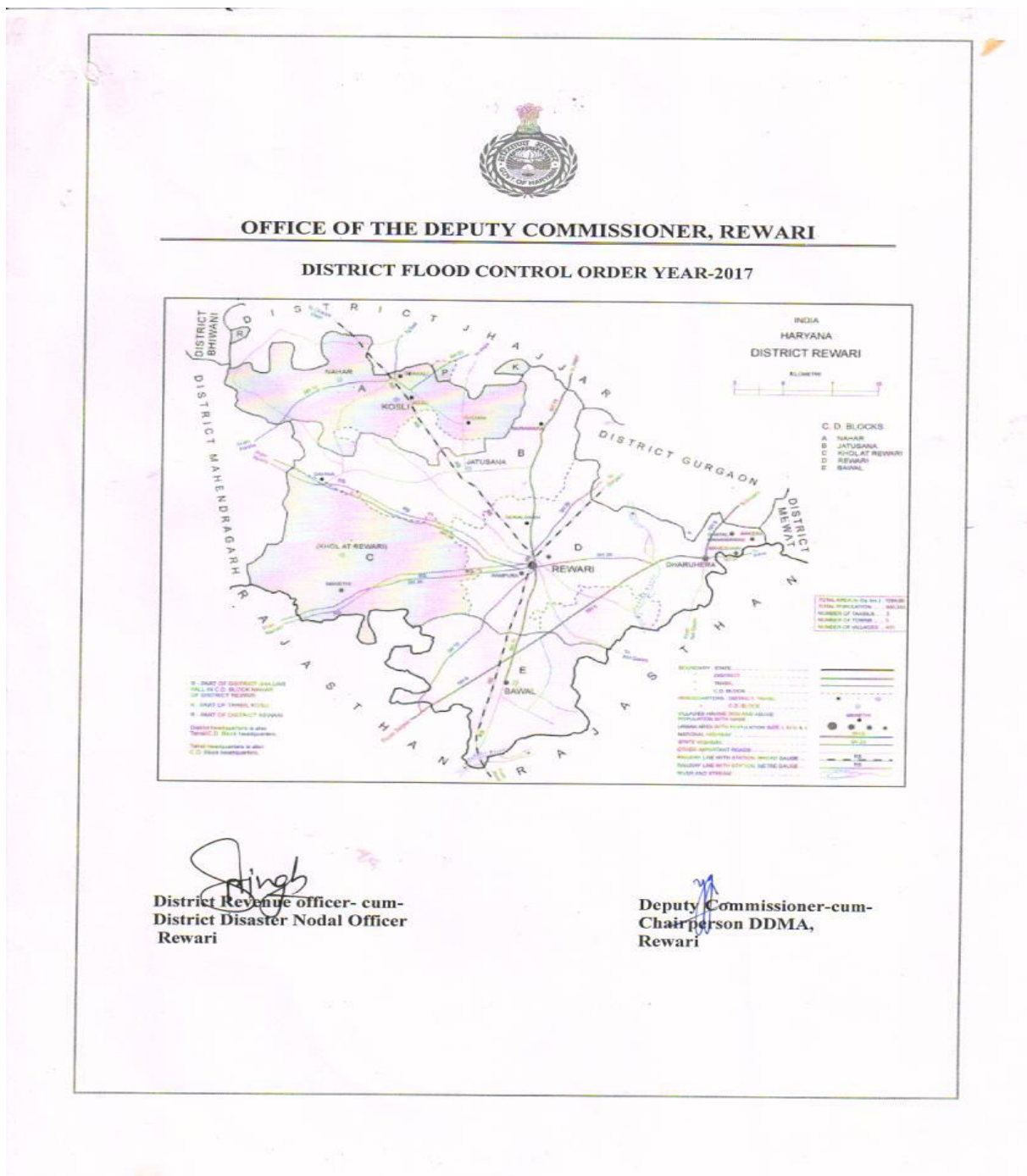




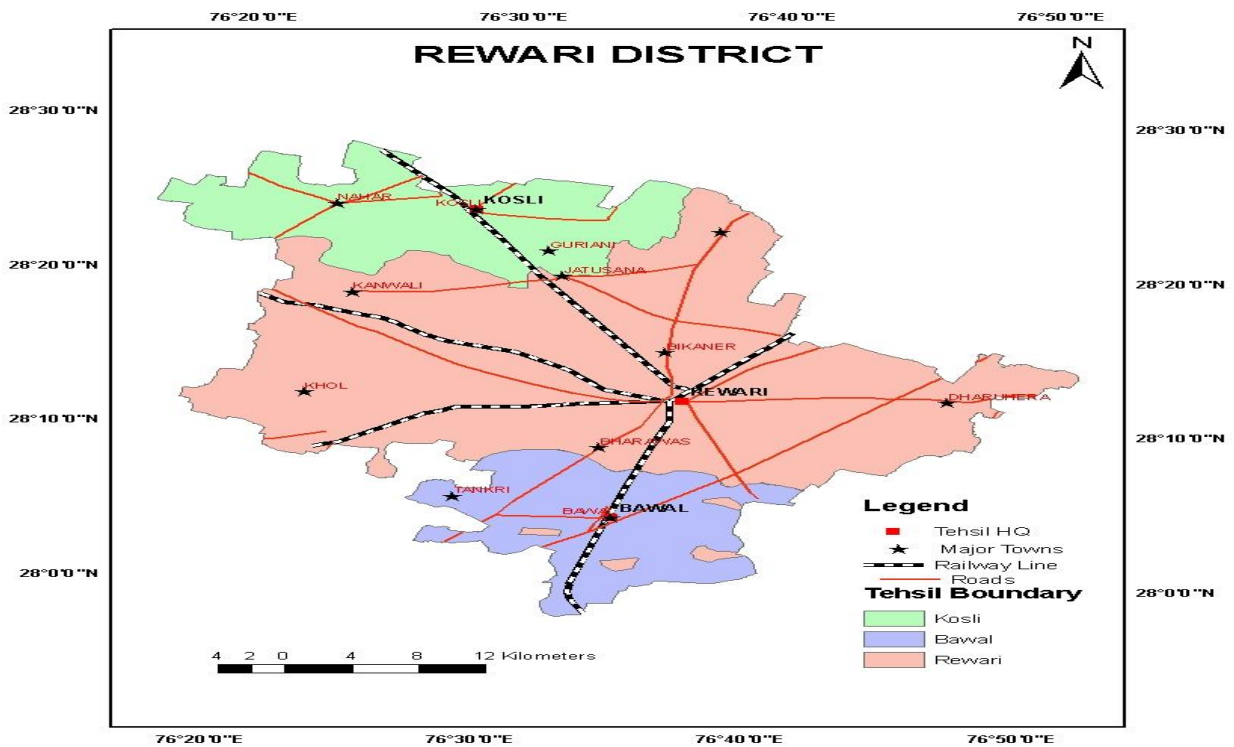
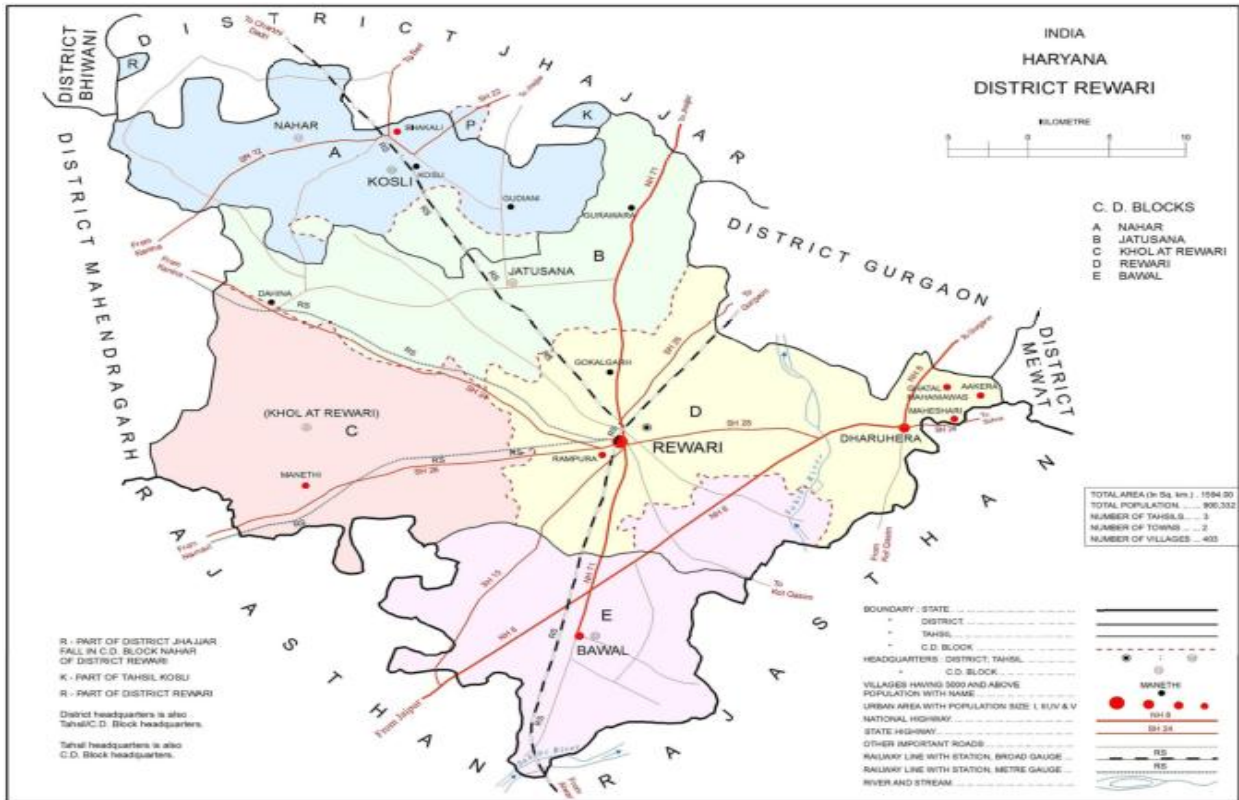

## Chapter -01

### Introduction

1.1 Rewari District which has been carved out from the erstwhile Mohindergarh District come in to existence on Sept. 01, 1989 is situated in South-East part of the state Haryana bordering Rajasthan. Rewari lies between 27.46 - 28.28' North latitudes and 76.15'-76.51' East longitudes. Its geographical boundaries have district Jhajjar to its north, Mahendergarh district to its west and district Gurgaon to its east & north-east and district Alwar of Rajasthan to its south directions. Total geographical area of district is 1594 Sq. km. Total population as per census 2011 is 8,96,126 person.

1.2 Administrative structure of District:- The Rewari district falls in Gurgaon Division. The district is further divided into three Sub-Divisions and five blocks, one Municipal council and two municipal committees for purpose of administration. District at-a – glance as per under:-

1.3 **Land use pattern of District:-** The total geographical area of district is 1,50,678 hectares. It's almost all parts fall under poor fertile zone. It has around 87.65% land under

agriculture purpose or cultivated. Land under build up area is around 5.50%. It indicates the district has very less development in terms of urbanization. It is mainly rural in nature. Only 3.29% areas cover under forest. The use of land as per below in district:-

**1.4 Climate and Rainfall pattern of district-** The climate of Rewari district can be classified as tropical steppe, Semiarid and hot which is mainly dry with very hot summer and cold winter except during monsoon. The annual average rainfall received in district is 480 mm. The rainfall in the district increases from the south-west towards the north-east. About 70 per cent of the annual rainfall is received during period from July to September.

## Chapter-02

### Drainage and Irrigation system in District

---

2.1 The district Rewari is one of the south-eastern districts of Haryana. Topographically, the area comprises small hillocks as a part of Aravalli range and sand-dunes. There is no perennial stream in the district.

There is no perennial stream in the District Rewari. The main streams in the district are Sahibi and Krishnawati rivers. Sahibi River is an *ephemeral river* and rises from Mewat hills in Jaipur Alwar in Rajasthan and after gathering water from several tributaries, forms a broad stream and enters the district near Pawti, Tehsil Bawal after which it enters Rajasthan and then re-enters Haryana near village Jarthal. The district, except in its Eastern part is flat and sandy and absorbs all the rain water.

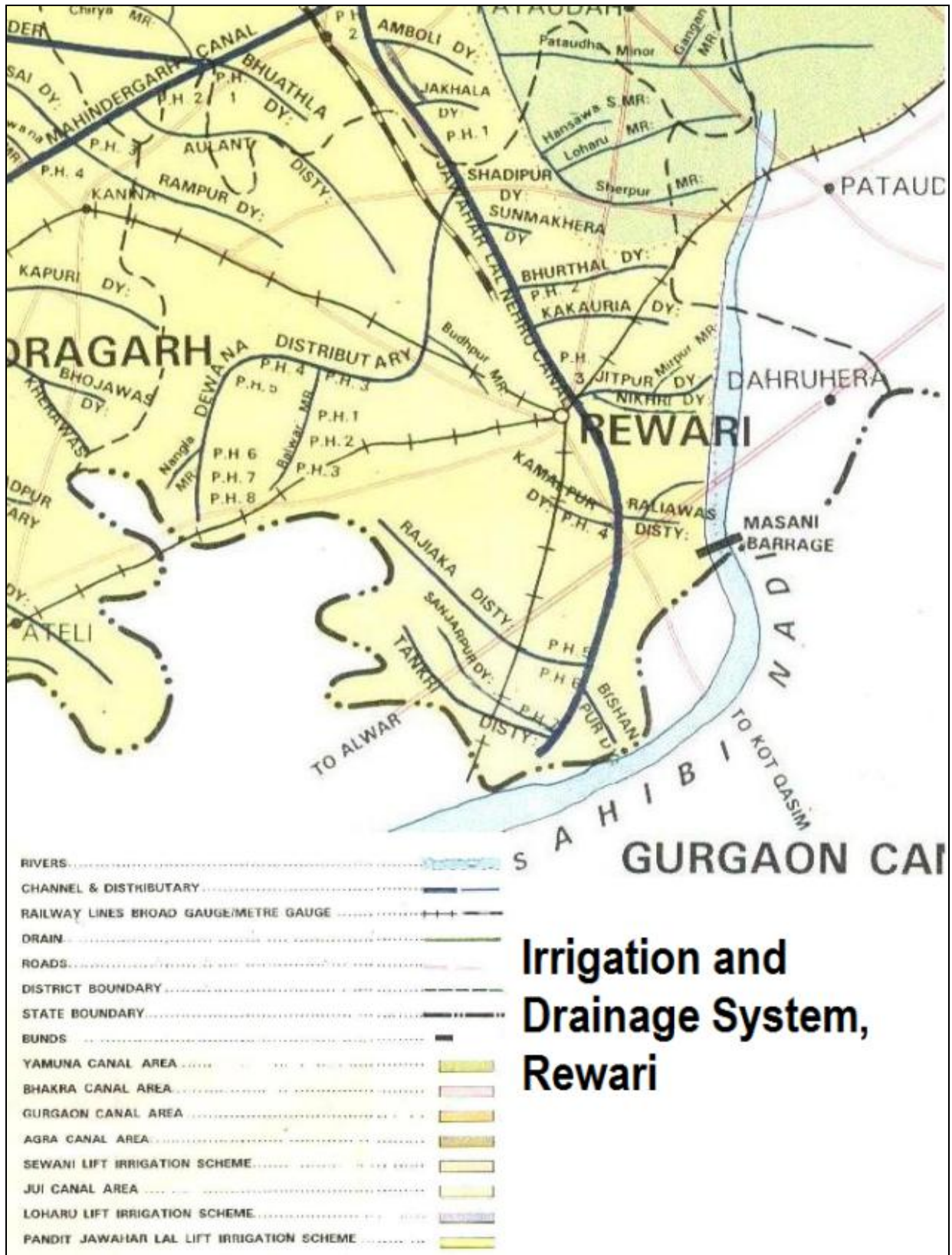
The Krishnawati River enters in the Southern part from Mahendragarh district and nearly makes a border between Mahendragarh and Rewari district. This is a blind river and its water gets absorbed by sandy soils. The flooding water is useful for crops and contributes to ground water recharge. There are various other small nalas also carry rain water from the hills during monsoon season.

2.2 The main canal of district is JawahLal Nehru canal. It's distributives i.e. Dawana Disty, Sunmakhera Disty, Bhurthal Disty, Kakauria Disty, Jitpur Disty, Raliwas Disty, Kamalpur Disty, Rajiaka Disty, Tankari Disty and Sunjarpur Disty are irrigated the largest area in the North, middle and south part of district.

The Aulant and Rampurr distributives of Mahindergarh canal also irrigated the west part of District.

The Pataudi minor, Hansawa minor, Loharu minor and sherpur minor are irrigated the north part of District.

## Chapter-03

### Flood Vulnerability in District

---

3.1 In general, there is no flood like situation during the Monsoon Season. There are two main streams, viz. the Sahibi and the Krishnavati enter the district from Rajasthan. All these cause floods in the rainy season and have been a source of damage in the district. The District was flooded due to heavy rains in the catchments area of river Sahibi which is situated in the Southeastern part of the district. Maximum discharge was experienced in the year 1977 in this river and many villages of the district were affected during the period.

Keeping in view the flood loss in the region, Masani Barrage constructed of in 1980 but after the construction of Masani Barrage, the river has ceased to carry the run-off because of the reason that a number of check dams have been constructed by Rajasthan Govt. across certain tributaries which used to carry water in river Sahibi.

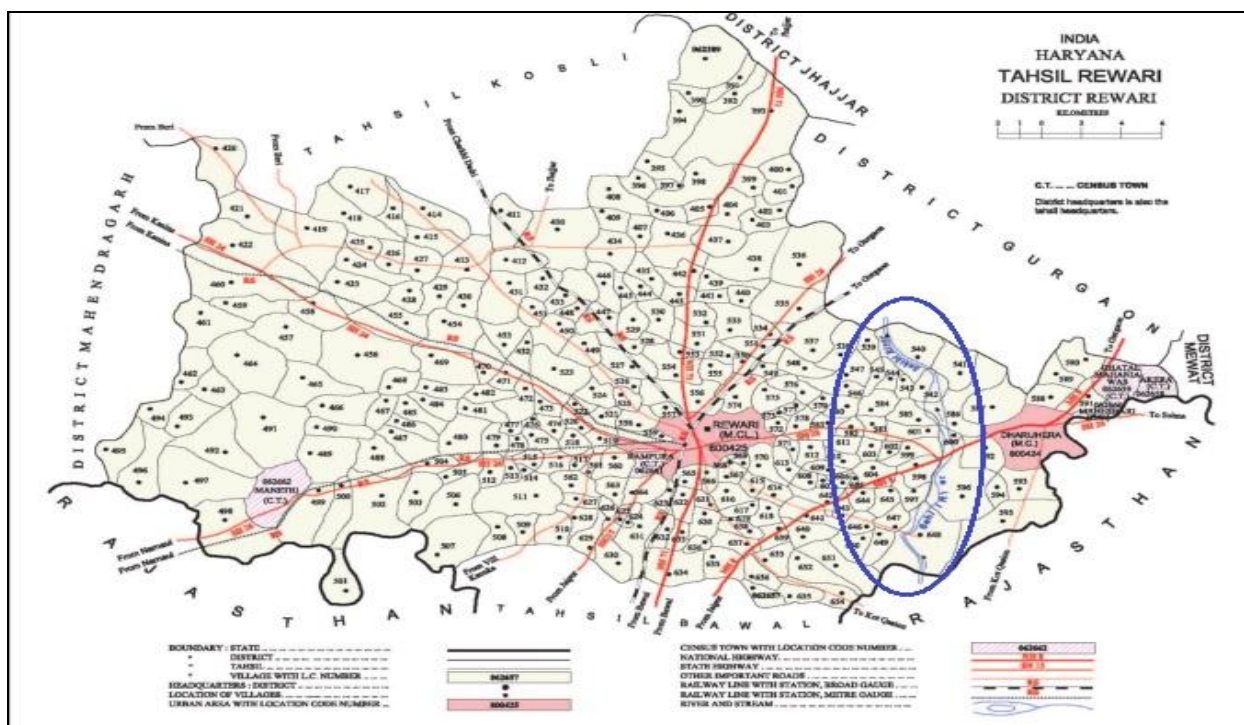
The last flood was observed in the Year 1995-96 with local affects along Sahibi River basin due to sudden discharge in the order of 50,000 Cs was received in District Rewari due to failure of series of earthen check Bunds in Alwar District, Rajasthan due to Cloud Burst. This type of situation can also arise in the future as well. The maps 3.1 and 3.2 shows the pathways of river Sahibi in Tehsils.

In addition to this, flood water also enters in Rewari Town passing through villages Nangli Godha, Bharawas, Chhuriawas and Dhamlawas when ever there is heavy rain in the Arawali foothills of Tankri area. However Rewari drain has been constructed and made functional to intercept this flood water and allowed to flow in JLN Canal avoiding inundation of Rewari Town. One more point entering flood water from the Arawali foothills of khol area is Nangal Mundi village where protection bund around the village had also been constructed.

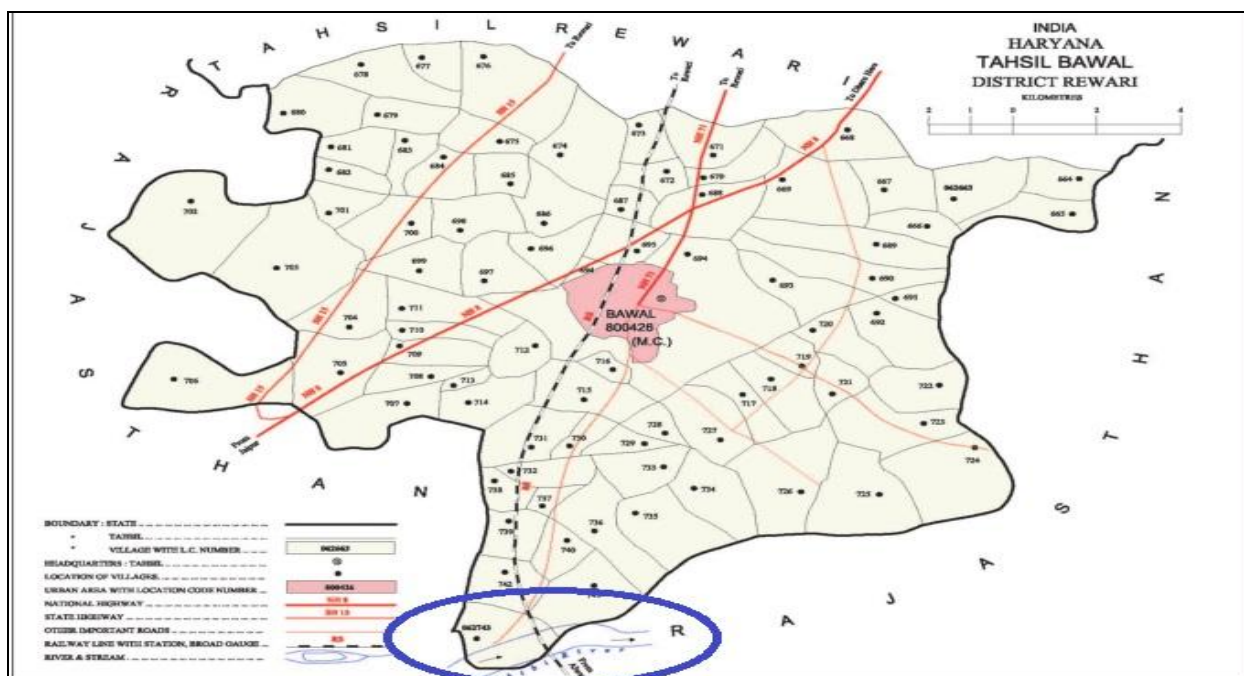
3.2 During the previous rainy seasons, it was experienced that a sheet flow emerges right of Rewari-Dharuhera road near village Hansaka and crosses this road at 3-4 points. This sheet flow of flood water cause inconvenience to traffic and public in general and disrupts normal life. Necessary culverts are being constructed by PWD (B&R) authorities at appropriate places under this road to provide relief to the traffic movement and Abadi in the adjacent areas.

3.3 During the year 2006, there were heavy rains in the area of Tapukara hills of Rajasthan and the flood water passing through Bhiwadi inundated NH-8 near Dharuhera town and Alawalpur village disrupting traffic movement and normal public life for 2-3 days. Necessary

steps are being taken by NHAI authorities to provide passage to this water by constructing the drains.

All of above, breaches also reported in JNL canal in monsoon season in the year 1995 as well as 2010. It may also cause of flooding in small pockets.

However, there are few chronic flood prone villages where flood may occur due to their topographical and geographic reasons during monsoon season.

## Chapter-04

### Flood preparedness

*In charges of Flood Control Room:-*

*District Revenue Officer-cum-

**4.1 Setup Flood control Room:-** The District Flood Control Room will be set up in the office of the Deputy Commissioner, Rewari and Tehsil head quarters w.e.f. 28.05.2017. Telephone No. of District Flood Control Room is 01274-225145. District Revenue Officer will be the Officer-in-charge of the District Flood Control Room. Tehsildar and Naib Tehsildar will be the in-charge of Flood Control Room of their Tehsils/ Sub Tehsil respectively. Flood Control Room will also be set up in the office of S.D.O.(C) Rewari/Kosli/Bawal. The list of important contact numbers in Chapter-7.

Daily flood situation report in the prescribed proforma will be submitted to District Flood Control Room by the S.D.O. (C) Rewari/Kosli/Bawal and Tehsildar/ BDPOs after obtaining the same from Sector In-charges or field staff so as to reach the Deputy Commissioner Office by 9:00 A.M. every morning positively, by the Police Radio Message or through special messenger or any other expeditious means. Similarly daily rainfall report from the rain gauge station will be transmitted by the Tehsildars and Naib Tehsildars through Police Radio message or through special message or on telephone to the District Flood Control Room/Sadar Office.

A Flood Control Room will be set up by Irrigation Department in Canal Colony, Rewari w.e.f. 20.05.2017. The Flood Control Room will be under the charge of Executive Engineer, W.S. Division No.-I, Rewari.

**4.2 Pre- flood Inspection:-** The joint inspection was carried out by various concerned departments on 02.05.2017 and 12.05.2017 for carrying out inspection of all vulnerable points/spots in connection with flood control preparedness in District Rewari.

**4.3 Flood Warning system:-** No part of Rewari District is subjected to direct river action, however, emergency messages are required to be sent regarding the discharge in Sahibi River from Masani Barrage as well as discharge at village patois. *Executive Engineer W/S Division No 2, Rewari will be made arrangement for transmission of information from Masani Barrage and to supply the discharge in Sahibi river at Masani Barrage*, by Police Radio Message, telephonic message to the District Flood Control Room and Deputy Commissioner, Camp Office.

Attempts may be made by the villages to cut roads or railway line for dewatering the flooded water from abadi on their fields. The Superintendent of Police, Rewari and concerned S.D.M and Executive Engineer of the concerned department will coordinate to regulate patrolling of such places and send their reports to Deputy Commissioner.

Officers/Official of Irrigation and P.W.D. Departments will carry out the vigilance and patrolling where possibility of branches of drains/Canal/bunds/ Roads etc. is exits.

The concerned BDPO's may raise their demands for funds from MNREGA within a week time for repairing these ring bunds if required so.

**4.6 Clearance of Drains/Nalans:-** The Executive Officer, Municipal Council Rewari and Secretary Bawal/ Dharuhera will ensure the clearance of the Drains/Nalans in Rewari/Bawal/Dharuhera towns before the rainy season starts. They will also ensure that there is no accumulation of water in their Jurisdiction area during rainy season. All the drains /nalans should be cleaned before 30.6.2017.

The Executive Engineer, Public Health & Engineering Rewari/ Kosli & Sewerage Division, Rewari and Executive Engineer Water Services Division No. 1 & 2, Executive Engineers NHAI, NH-71B, Executive Engineers HUDA, Executive Engineer PWD (B&R) will be responsible for the clearance of Drains/ Storm drains/ Nalans/ Main Holes under their jurisdiction.

**5.1 Flood Relief Equipments:-** The District Revenue Officer-cum-District Disaster Relief Officer, Rewari will be over all in-charge of flood relief equipments. The OBMs will be tested and checked for use before 30-05-2017. D.R.O. cum DDRO Rewari will be responsible for the completion of this work. The Flood Relief Equipment available along with its location is given below:-

**5.2 Dewatering :-** It will be the primary responsibility of the Irrigation Department to carry out Dewatering Operation from Abadis as well as fields from the flood villages. SDM

Rewari, Kosli and Bawal will provide assistance to Executive Engineer, Mechanical Division, Rewari for speedily dewatering operations.

a) All the pumping sets have been tested by the Executive Engineer, Mechanical Division, and Rewari *before 30.05.2017*. The connection at vulnerable sites will be given by the D.H.V.B.N. at all sites which will be required by the Executive Engineer, Mechanical Division, Rewari. For this purpose, sufficient stocking of equipment such as transformers etc. will be ensured by the D.H.V.B.N. authorities Dewatering Operation in the entire District will be taken jointly by the Irrigation, Revenue and Development Department depending upon the nature of floods and the exigencies of the situations. Executive Engineer, Mechanical Division, Rewari has already identified the sites where temporary pumping sets will be installed and where electric connection will be required. Position of Diesel Pump Set and Electric Pump Sets is given as under:-

All the above pumps are in working condition. However, Executive Engineer, Mechanical Division Rewari will ensure that the pumps are in working condition before 30-05-2016. S.E. JLN W/s Circle will also check these pumps and ensure that these are in working condition.

b) **Detail of permanent/temporary sites where electric pumps to be installed/connection to be taken before 30-06-2017:-** These are two sites Jatusana and Nainsukhpura where permanent electric pumps have been installed and connections taken. Apart from this, the XEN Mechanical Division Rewari have identified Two sites i.e. at Khera Alampur and Pahlawas where temporary connections are to be taken for dewatering in case of heavy rains/flood. The XEN Mechanical Division Rewari will be responsible for installing pumps and taking electric connection well before time S.E. JLN W/s Circle Rewari will ensure the dewatering from the Abadi & fields in the district. He will keep the situation monitoring and

inform the District Flood Control Room and Deputy Commissioner Rewari regarding the progress and situation.

c) Decision with regard to the request closed/reduction in discharge of canals in the District will be taken jointly by the Deputy Commissioner and S.E. JLN Water Services, Circle Rewari.

d) Sufficient stock of E.G. bags etc. will be ensured by the S.E. JLN, W/S Circle Rewari and Executive Engineer, Water Services Division No. 1 & 2, 3, Rewari for strengthening the embankments of drain bunds in case of heavy rains and flood.

## Chapte-06

### Flood Action Plan of Departments

---

**6.1 Department of Revenue and Disaster Management:-** The Department of revenue is coordination department for flood management in district. Department ensure resource inventory of flood relief and important contact number nodal and sub-nodal officer of front line departments.

- Provision of funds for carrying out relief operation.
- Identification of evacuation centers i.e. Safe schools, Dharamshalas and other community building for relocation of people in case of need.

**6.2 Department of Animal Husbandry:-** The Deputy Director, Animal Husbandry, Rewari is over all in-charge to make elaborate arrangement for prevention of water related and flood affected disease in live stock.

- To ensure sufficient quantities of preventive/curable medicine is stocked at district level and flood prone areas hospitals and clinics.
- To constitute veterinary teams for relief and response for flood prone areas.

**6.3 Department of Health:-** The Civil Surgeon Rewari will be overall in-charge and responsible for ensuring health coverage to the flood affected population.

- Set-up control room in the Civil Hospital Rewari by the Civil Surgeon in monsoon season.
- To prevent the possibility of outbreak of malaria or cholera epidemics and water born disease.
- To make arrangements for sufficient quantities of stocking of medicine and anti snake Venom Serum both at the Civil Hospital Rewari and at all the Primary Health Centers and dispensaries situated in the District.
- To ensure adequate supply of medicine at all the CHCs & P.H.Cs. and dispensaries in the event of floods.
- Anti-malaria spray will be got done by District Malaria Officer.
- Medical relief will be provided in the flood affected villages both as preventive as well as curative measures.
- To make arrangement for chlorination of drinking water wells in all Villages.
- Civil Surgeon and Medical Officers of the concerned P.H.C./C.H.C/ Dispensaries will be responsible for making necessary arrangement for providing medicines other health facilities to the effected population of the flood affected villages.

- Medical Officers will send daily report to Civil Surgeon and District Headquarter regarding the situation. Civil Surgeon will also monitor the situation and send the report to Deputy Commissioner Office and District Flood Control Room.

**6.4 Department of food and civil supply:-** The District Food and Supplies Controller, Rewari ensure elaborate arrangements for supply of essential commodities such as Atta, Rice, Sugar, Cooking Oil, Kerosene oil, Petrol, Diesel, Domestic gas cylinders etc. in all the flood affected villages.

- To provide essential commodities in all affected villages of the District through the existing net work of public distribution system.
- The supply of essential commodities in the district is maintained through a network of total 306 Fair Price Shops, 16 gas agencies and 5 kerosene oil dealers.
- The sector in charges will help the DFSC/DFSO in disbursement of essential commodities in the flood affected villages.
- Sector in changes will also inform day to day situation to respective SDM's and also report to Flood Control Room. SDM's s will supervise the work in their respective jurisdiction.

**6.5 Department of Forest:-** Divisional Forest Officer Rewari is overall in-charge to ensure clearance of road blockage in case of falling of trees etc. during the rainy season/flood and ensure that the roads/ banks etc. are cleared at the earliest possible.

- If the crane is required for this purpose, the same could be requisitioned from the G. M. Haryana Roadways, Rewari. He may seek any type of assistance from SDM of Rewari, Kosli and Bawal.
- G.M. Haryana Roadways and XEN PWD (B&R) Rewari will also provide assistance to the Divisional Forest officer Rewari.
- Concern officers will remain in touch with the Deputy Commissioner during the flood and will also send their report regarding the situation to District Flood Control Room and Deputy Commissioner Camp Office as well.

**6.6 Department of Public Health & Engineering:-** S.E. Public Health Engineering Circle, Rewari will be over all in charge for water supply and sanitation in flood affected areas.

- The Executive Engineers Public Health Engineering department will make necessary arrangements for carrying out chlorination of all rural water works in the events of floods.
- To make sure arrangements for sufficient number of hand pumps will be installed in flood affected villages by the Executive Engineer.



- To make arrangements will be made by the Executive Engineers, for digging of trench type latrines in villages which could be used by marooned people during floods.
- To make arrangements of water tankers for water supply in flood affected areas.

**6.7 Department of Power Supply:** S.E. DHBVN, Rewari will be over all in charge for proper supply of electricity and repair transmission lines, electrical poles as and when required before and after flood in flood prone areas in district.

**6.8 Department of Irrigation:** S.E. Irrigation, Rewari will be over all in charge for flood protection work on Sahibi River and ring bundhs in villages and ensure proper work & discharge of Rewari Drain and Jattusana Drain.

- To Set-up control room in during the monsoon season round the clock.
- To Check all pump houses and flood pool pumps in running condition.
- To procure sufficient material such as sand bags, etc.
- To Inspection and repair culverts as and when required.
- To keep regular watch on all the vulnerable and problematic point keeping in view of previous year experience.

**6.9 Department of Public Relation:-** A Media Centre shall be operational in the office of District Information and Public Relation Officer, Rewari under the overall supervision of DIPRO.

- He will collect daily necessary information from the different department regarding rainfall, flow of water in different drains, stagnation of water, rescue operations and the efforts made by different department to drain out rain water or to provide relief and shall brief the press, so that actual picture is brought to the notice of public/government.

**6.10 Department of Telecommunication (Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited):-** General Manager Telecom will be provide provisions for communications support in case any Flood situation..

- Provide communication facilities as and when require.
- Restore communication in the affected areas as early as possible.

**6.11 Department of PWD(B&R):** S.E. PWD(B&R), Rewari will be over all in charge to carryout of construction works & repair of roads during monsoon season due to flood.

- To inspect of culverts of village approach roads so they may not obstruct drainage water during the flood.
- All The culvers on highways and district roads will be checked and ensure for cross drainage water.

6.12 **Department of Police:** Superintendent of Police, Rewari will be over all in charge to maintain law and order and carry out patrolling in flood prone areas.

- Ensure communication system for warning and dissemination of information during flood through wireless system.
- To conduct search and rescue operation with support of Revenue, Home guards, Heath & Red Cross and fire safety departments as and when require during the monsoon season.

6.13 **Department of Development and Panchayat :** DDPO will be over all in charge to inspect and repair of ring bundhs in rural areas with support of irrigation department and constitute Village level Disaster Management committee of concerned Sarpanch, Patwari, Gram sachiv, ANM, Anganwari worker and concerned teacher of the school in rural area.

6.14 **Sector Officers:** Sector officers are responsible for Evacuation and provide temporary shelters & relief camps to flood affected people during monsoon season and arrange all essential commodities in relief camps with coordination of front line departments.
