

**ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973.**

Whereas, it has been made appear to me that there is the possibility that today, on the expiry of "Janta Curfew" at 2100 hrs today, people may spill out into the streets to congratulate each other or just to celebrate this event. This would entirely negate and neutralize all the benefits of "Janta Curfew".

And whereas, I am satisfied that immediate measures are need to be taken to prevent such circumstances to ensure the safety of general public. There is apprehension of spread of COVID-19 in case of public gathering.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, I, Yashendra Singh, I.A.S., District Magistrate, Rewari, do, hereby prohibit the assembly of five or more persons in public place in district Rewari with immediate effect.

The order shall not apply to the police and other public servants on duty. Adequate consideration may however be provided to movement of people in public transport or in any other mode of transport specially in the eventuality of medical emergencies.

The superintendent of Police, Rewari, Sub Divisional Magistrates, All Executive Magistrates, All Deputy Superintendents of Police, All SHOs shall implement this order. The order shall remain in force till further order. The order is being passed ex-parte the situation being emergent.

This order shall be promulgated throughout the District through media, by publicity van, by District Public Relation Officer, Rewari, by beat of drums, affixing the order on notice boards and hosting on the district official website [www.rewari.gov.in](http://www.rewari.gov.in).
