Sub: Regarding reporting incidents of violation of notification of lockdown issued by Ministry Home Affairs Dt 24.03.2020

In response to the notification of MHA mentioned above In the Subject, the state is regularly sending its report twice a day (9 AM and 3 PM). The Google spreadsheets were circulated to all concerned. There are some discrepancies observed by MHA officials regarding total number of incidents of violation of lockdown/ curfew in Haryana.

2. In some instance, the number of violations instead of increasing (Cumulative numbers), the incidents have reduced. There should be clarity on what exactly constitutes a violation. In this regard, it is clarified that any person who is commuting in public place without any valid ground or without any travel permit is liable to be booked under IPC 188/IPC 269/IPC 270/ NDMA, 2005. The grounds for such exemptions have been separately listed for essential commodities by MHA separately. Those persons undertaking essential services are exempted and obliged to produce the relevant I card on demand by Law enforcement agencies/ Executive Magistrates / police agencies. Even transport of non-essential commodities has been exempted by a separate order by MHA.
3. Accordingly, any traffic violation should be treated as violation of lockdown and booked as such. For example, a person commuting in public place without a valid permit will constitute a lockdown violation. But, additionally if he is not wearing a helmet cannot be shown separately as a lockdown violation and will be considered as a single incident.
4. Accordingly, true information/ data / figures regarding FIR registered, arrests made and vehicles seized may be entered in Google spreadsheet. Any discrepancy in reportage in this regard will be seriously considered as per NDMA Act, 2005.


