**Subject: - Movement Combine Harvesters/ Allied Agriculture machinery and staff in the state.**

On the Subject cited above, as the whole nation is battling with COVID-19 scare and there is complete lockdown in the country. But to continue the food supply chain, the farmers are being facilitated for mechanized harvesting.

As the movement of combine harvester & allied machinery has been allowed by the GoI and the same as moving from one state to another for harvesting. In this regard, some queries have been received from the police authorities i.e Ambala (copy enclosed). The general instructions w.r.t queries as cited above are as under:

1. 3-5 persons (owner/helper/drivers) are required to run/operate the combine harvester.
2. The constitution of the teams for sanitization is to be taken at the district level and the persons from health deptt. may be taken in the team.
3. Regarding transportation and other process of combine from one district/State, GoI has already issued the guidelines for the same vide letter dated: 27.03.2020 followed by letter dated: 03.04.2020.
4. Regarding trolley and other allied agriculture machinery, attention is drawn towards the guidelines issued by GoI dated: 27.03.2020. The same are reproduced as under:

**e. Intra and Inter-state movement of harvesting and sowing related machines like combined harvester and other agriculture/ horticulture implements”.**

5. The matter regarding shift duties of the team is to be taken up by the concerned DDAs as per availability of machines, staff and the area under crop to be harvested. The instructions/advisory may be issued keeping in view the guidelines issued by GoI/ State from time to time.

The guidelines issued by GoI/ State and various districts authorities is attached herewith for ready reference.

The above cited instructions may be followed in letter and spirit.


