**Subject: Regarding disposal of used face masks, hand gloves and hazmat suits etc.**

Please find enclosed herewith a copy of letter no. HSPCB/HQ/SWM/2020/94096 dated 16.04.2020 received from HSPCB on the subject note above.

As you aware that wearing of mask has been made mandatory while stepping outside the home in the State during lockdown to contain the spread of Covid-19. A large no. of people is using disposable masks/ gloves etc. in the rural areas every day and it is generating large amount of disposable waste.

The Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, during the Crisis Coordination Committee Video Conference meeting held on 05-04-2020, has also emphasized that the used face masks, hand-gloves and hazmat-suits etc. from the individual households, offices, quarantine houses and other units may be collected separately from the household waste and to be handed over to the concerned CHCs/PHCs/ Sub-Health Centers for their scientific disposal by the concerned Municipalities/ Gram Panchayats.

You are, therefore, requested

1. To instruct the Sarpanches to get this waste collected (used masks/gloves etc.) in routine manner in yellow bags being provided by CHCs/PHCs/ Sub-Health Centers in their respective villages and hand over this collected waste to concerned CHCs/PHCs/ Sub-Health Centers for further scientific disposal by the to the authorized Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment facilities, details of which are given in the enclosed letter.
2. To ensure separate collection of used masks/gloves etc. from the household waste.
3. To use the services of engaged agencies/ SafaiKaramcharis engaged by the Gram Panchayats for separate collection of these wastes from the

5. To report all the above mentioned activities in an online web application developed for this purpose. The details of the web application will be shared shortly. The data entry in the application may be got done through the concerned CSC operator of the Gram Panchayat. Meanwhile information may be collected in the format (which will be later on entered in the web application) as given below:




