Covid-19 pandemic - Movement of stranded agricultural labour.

Memo.

May kindly refer to Govt. of India, MHA's order dated 29.04.2020 followed by Haryana Govt. SOP issued vide endst. No. SPL/101/Covid/2020 dated 03.05.2020 and this office WAN message No.26462-571/Misc. Desk/SB-CID, dated 05.05.2020.

2. Tentative schedule of train to facilitate the transportation of agricultural labourers only back to their native places, stranded due to N-Covid-19 pandemic from Rewari to Sagar (Madhya Pradesh) is on 07.05.2020. In this train, agricultural labourers of Madhya Pradesh stranded in District Rewari/adjoining districts belonging to following districts of Madhya Pradesh:

Guna, Gwalior, Chatarpur, Tikamgarh, Deiya, Damoh, Panna, Bhind, Muraina, Sheopur, Sagar, Niwadi & Mahoba.

are proposed to be transported. You are requested to ensure:-

- 1. The District Nodal Officers (Civil) with the assistance of GM, Roadways of their respective districts shall ensure the smooth movement of such agricultural labourers from different locations of their districts to the shelter homes of District Rewari.
- 2. The data base of all the agricultural labourers to be transported shall be properly maintained by each district in the enclosed proforma.

3. DC & SP Rewari shall ensure proper thermal screening of all the passengers (Agricultural labour) by today evening. DC & SP/Rewari will make proper arrangements of their stay in the shelter homes and ensure availability of clean toilet facilities, sufficient no. of masks, sanitizers and the medical teams at the designated shelter homes. DC & SP/ Rewari shall also ensure similar facilities at Railway Station Rewari.
4. The agricultural labourers having symptoms of COVID-19 shall be immediately isolated and NOT to be allowed to board the train, and are to be further dealt with as per the COVID-19 protocol.
5. The district authorities shall also ensure that the appropriate arrangements for their food, water and other basic essential needs are made.
6. It shall also be ensured that the labourers destined for a particular district of a State are to be seated in the same coach/bogy.
7. **FOR SP/GRP ONLY:** She shall coordinate with and provide all necessary assistance to the district officials for smooth boarding of such labourers from the designated railway station i.e. Rewari while maintaining social distancing norms and following COVID-19 protocol. She shall also depute a DSP rank officer for better coordination with DC/SP Rewari.
8. It may be ensured that all persons boarding the train shall be wearing protective face masks. District Nodal Officer may provide them, if necessary, hand sanitizers in every coach of the train. Sh. Hamid Akhtar, IPS, SP/Security-II (98134-43555) camp at Rewari and DSP/CID Rewari (98469-99772) shall coordinate all these arrangements with DC & SP, Rewari and SP/GRP.
9. Food packets, dry snacks/refreshment/drinking water may also be provided to those boarding the train.
10. DC & SP/ Rewari shall be personally responsible to coordinate and stay of agricultural in the shelter homes, proper data base, their boarding into the train and enforcement of social distancing norms.

Please ensure compliance.
