## OFFICE OF THE DISTRICT MAGISTRATE, REWARI

### OFFICE ORDER

In continuation of vide Order Endst. No. 624-28/COVID-19 dated 24.03.2020.

Directions have been received by Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India vide letter no 40-3/2020- DM-1 (A) dated 05-05-2020 of Standard Operating Protocols (SOPs), for movement of Indian National stranded outside the country and specified persons to travel abroad.

In order to implement these orders a meeting was held under the Chairmanship of City Magistrate, Sh.Sanjeev Kumar, HCS, of Hotel Association and GMs of few hotels located in district Rewari.

Pursuant to the discussions in the meeting following decisions were arrived at:

1. As per above stated orders of MHA, the Indian Nationals stranded outside the country have to be kept in institutional quarantine facility for a minimum period of 14 days.

This facility will be made available by Government and private hotels located in the district at the rates decided in the meeting with their consent.

2. For the price mentioned above, following facilities will be provided by the hotel authorities:-
  - a.) The Meals (i.e. Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner) per day
  - b.) Two Bottles of Mineral Water per day.

- c.) Material for preparation of Tea and Coffee in the room with requisite material as per standard practice.
  - d.) Other similar facilities as provided to norms guests of the hotel including Wi-Fi, Television etc.
  - e.) The payment shall be made by the actual beneficiary from the day the beneficiary occupies the rooms. however, request for payment of advance may be avoided.
  - f.) Meals to such guest shall be served in their room only in disposable plates/containers. The plates used for this purpose should be disposed as BIO-Medical Waste ensuring due protocol.
  - g.) The hotel shall deploy their security personnel in such a way so that movement of their guest through CCTV in their control room.
  - h.) The additional terms and conditions, as decided by the District authority shall be binding on the hotel management.
3. The hotels providing the accommodation shall follow the Standard Operating Procedure as directed by CMO, Rewari which will be shared with District Administration from time to time.
  4. Civil Surgeon will constitute medical teams for testing for COVID-19 post completion of institutional quarantine and co-ordinate for necessary medical requirements as per protocol.
  5. Sh. Vijay Yadav, Counter In-charge, Jungle Babblers (9416382899), Haryana Tourism will co-ordinate with the hotels and with officials in Ministry of External Affairs and keep the district administration and hotels informed about number of guests arriving, date and time of arrival and all other necessary logistics. Any directions issued in this regard will be communicated by Sh. Vijay Yadav, Counter In-charge, Jungle Babblers (9416382899), Haryana Tourism to all the hotels in Annexure 'A'. He will be nodal-cum-liaison officer for the purpose.
  6. Sh. Naveen Sharma, (9896727478) GM Haryana Roadway, Rewari will coordinate with, Sh. Rajinder Kumar Sharma (Liaison Officer Haryana Tourism, Delhi Office, Mob No. 9818590913) to provide buses for transportation of Indian Nationals from Delhi airport to their respective hotels.
