

## ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973

Whereas it has been made to appear to me that heavy vehicles are passing through the city round the clock not only causing traffic congestion and traffic hazard but also increasing level of dust/vehicular pollution which is hazardous to health and is main reason for respiratory problems/covid-19. The movement of heavy vehicles during day time invites accidents and the apprehension of any untoward incident and loss of public life and property cannot be ruled out.

In view of the above, I, Yashendra Singh, IAS, District Magistrate, Rewari, invoking the powers conferred under section 144 Cr. PC do, hereby, prohibit the movement of heavy traffic in the entire municipal limits of Rewari from 08:00 AM to 08:00PM except the government vehicle and the vehicles carrying essential goods that is i.e Vegetable, Medicine, Milk, COVID/Medical related items etc. in the interest of maintenance of public, health, hygiene and safety.

The compliance of this order shall be strictly enforced and any violation of the same shall be strictly dealt with as per sections of 188, 269 and 270 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.


The order shall be promulgated by uploading it on the District website, circulated it through WhatsApp groups, and on their mediums of social/digital media, whenever the same is not possible through these methods, may also be used and shall be promulgated at in the area of District Rewari by beat of drum, by announcement through the publicity van of Public Relation Department.

In view of the requirement of the situation which has become emergent, this order is passed ex-parte and is addressed to the public at large.


