

## ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973

Whereas it has been made to appear to me that there is an apprehension of disturbance to peaceful conduct of HTET examination being conducted in three sessions by Haryana School Education Board, Bhiwani on dated 02.01.2021 and 03.01.2021 at 18 examination centers in Rewari district.

And whereas, I am satisfied that directions are necessary to prevent obstruction or annoyance or injury to persons lawfully employed for the conduct of the exam and to prevent any apprehension of disturbance of public tranquility and to prevent riot or affray so that the examinations may held smoothly.

Now, therefore, in exercising of the powers vested in me by virtue of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, I, Rahul Hooda, I.A.S., District Magistrate, Rewari do, hereby, prohibit:

1. Carrying of any weapons on dated 02.01.2021 and 03.01.2021 within 200 meters of all the examination centers in district Rewari.
2. Entry of any unauthorized persons in examination centers in Rewari District on dated 02.01.2021 and 03.01.2021 and without carrying duly issued ID cards on their person conspicuously.
3. Functioning of all the photocopying machine shops situated within a radius of 200 meters around the examination centers in district Rewari from 2 hours before the commencement of each exam till 1 hour after the completion of the exam on 02.01.2021 and 03.01.2021.



This order shall remain in force within the limits of examination centers of Rewari district on dated 02.01.2021 and 03.01.2021. This order shall not apply to Police personnels and other public servants on duty.

In view of urgency in the matter this order is passed ex-parte and addressed to the general public. The order shall be enforced by all Sub-Divisional Magistrates, Deputy Superintendents of Police, Station House Officers, Duty Magistrates, Chief and Centre Superintendents, Flying Squads and other officers on duties related to the HTET, 2020 Examination.

This order shall be promulgated throughout the Rewari District through media, by publicity vans by District Public Relation Officer, Rewari, by beat of drums, affixing the order on notice boards and hosting on the district official website [www.rewari.gov.in](http://www.rewari.gov.in).

Any violation of the same shall be strictly dealt with as per section 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.
