

## **LADLI LAXMI YOJANA**

For improving the health and educational status of the girls in the State, laying the foundation for better future, to prevent female feticide and to bring the positive attitude among people towards girl child birth and

with the aim to preventing child marriages, the "Ladli Laxmi Yojana" has been introduced in the State. The

plan is for the girls, born after 1st January 2006.

Who can take the advantages of the scheme - Such girls

(i) Whose parents are resident of Madhya Pradesh and they are not Income Tax payer.

(ii) In the case of second child, the family planning is adopted by the parents before submitting the application.

(iii) First girl child of first delivery who has born before 01/04/2008, but after the second delivery it will be necessary to adopt the family planning.

(iv) The beneficiary attends the Anganwadi Center regularly.

(v) If there is maximum two children in the family and their parents are not alive, then the condition of family

planning would not be applicable, but the death certificate of father and mother must be required.

(vi) ) If there is first child is boy or girl in the family and twins girls are born in second delivery, then all the

benefits of this plan will be given to both girl child.

(vii) If an orphan girl is adopted by the family, then benefits of this plan will be given to her by considering

her as the first girl child of the family.

(viii) In case of death of parents, the application can be submitted even up to the five years age of the girl child.

(ix) When three girl child are born together at the time of first delivery, then benefits of Ladli Laxmi Yojana will be given to all three girl child.

(x) Such guardians who had not submitted the application within the 1 year of birth of girl child, will be facilitated, that they will be able to appeal to the collector of the concerned district within the period of coming 1 year i.e. within the 2 years of the birth of the girl child. Collector will have absolute powers to accept or reject the case.

### **How and where to apply:**

(i) To avail the benefits of this scheme, people will have to apply at the Anganwadi Center of their village / locality.

(ii) All the prescribed document must be attached with the application.

(iii) In the case of orphan girl, the superintendent of the concerned orphanage / protection home will have to

apply to the concerned Project officer, before completing the 6 years of age and within the 1 year of admission of girl in the orphanage.

### **How long the registration can be done ?**

(i) The registration have unavoidably been done in any of the Anganwadi center of the State, within 1 year of birth.

(ii) To get registered in the scheme, parent / guardian will have to submit an application to concerned Anganwadi Worker, within the birth of girl child.

(iii) For such girl child who is the first child of their parents, and born before 31st March 2008, then it will be

necessary, to get registered and to apply within 1 year of birth of second child.

### **The supply of amount :**

After the approval of the case, National Saving Certificates of Rs. 6000/- will be purchased continuously up

to the 5 years in the name of beneficiary. and after that :-

Rs. 2000/- on the admission in 6 th class, Rs.4000/- on the admission in 9th class and Rs.7500/- on the admission, will be paid to the girl child as lump sum amount.

Remaining amount will be paid as lump sum on completion of 21 years of age and on appearing in the examination of 12th class, with the condition that the girl has been married only after 18 years of age.
