ORDERS UNDER RULE 10/84/88 OF THE EXPLOSIVE RULES, 2008

Sonipat the 11th November, 2020

No. 5761/PLA :Whereas, vide order No. DMC-SPIO--2020/13250, dated 09.11.2020 and No. DMC-SPO-2020/PS/CS/108993, dated 11.11.2020, Chief Secretary cum-Chairperson, Haryana State Executive Committee, SDMA has directed for strict implementation of the orders of Hon'ble NGT dated 09-11-2020 (OA No. 249 of 2020).

Whereas, remedial action against rising pollution due to burning of fire crackers needs to be taken. Further, in view of the ensuing COVID -19 pandemic, vulnerable people are to be protected.

And whereas I am satisfied that for immediate compliance of the aforesaid orders of Hon'ble NGT a complete ban is to be enforced on the sale and use of any kind of fire cracker in the district Sonipat.

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred U/S 10/84/88 of the Explosive Rules, 2008 **I, Shyam Lal Poonia, IAS, District Magistrate, Sonipat** do, hereby, order a complete ban on sale and use of any kind of fire crackers within the geographical limits of district Sonipat.

This order shall come into force with effect from midnight of 11th November, 2020 and will remain in force till midnight of 30th November,2020 to 1st December, 2020.

The Superintendent of Police, Sonipat, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Sonipat, Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Sonipat All Sub Divisional Magistrates, City Magistrate, DDPO, All Tehsildars/Naib Tehsildars, DSPs, BDPOs, EO/Secy. Municipal Council/Committees, SHOs of all police stations, Fire Officer and other fire department staff of District Sonipat shall ensure the compliance of this order. All officers are directed to conduct raids, alongwith SHOs concerned, wherever it seems necessary and initiate penal action as warranted.

Any violation of this order would be punishable under section 188 of IPC and Explosives Act 1884/Explosive Rules 2008 or any other provision applicable in this regard for the time being in force.

The District Public Relation Officer, Sonipat shall give wide publicity to this order throughout the District Sonipat and this order should also be sent to press for wide publicity. DIO is directed to post the order on official website www.sonipat.gov.in.

It is not possible to serve this notice to the public at large individually, so in view of emergent situation, this order is passed ex-parte and is addressed to public at large.
