PUBLIC NOTICE

The Government of Goa vide its order dated 04.09.2018 have constituted a committee for empanelment of the eminent senior Advocates under the Schedule Castes & Schedule Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 under the Chairmanship of the Secretary (Social Welfare) as required under Sub Rule 5 of Rule 4 of the SCs/STs (PoA) Act and Rules made thereunder and also regarding fixing of remuneration/fees of the eminent senior Advocates as provided under Sub Rule (6) of Rule 4.

The above committee during its first meeting held on 05.09.2018 has decided and accordingly issued directions to the District Magistrate, South Goa to prepare a panel of such eminent senior Advocates who have been in practice for not less than seven years, as deemed necessary for conducting cases in the Special Courts.

The following criteria is drawn based on the recommendation of the aforesaid Committee for the empanelment along with fees provided for category "A" and "B" as shall be applicable;

- (i) The eminent senior advocate to be appointed for the above purpose shall be an expert in the legal field with experience in dealing with the criminal matters preferably with a successful track record in the criminal matters related to the atrocities against SCs/STs.
- (ii) He shall also be well conversant with the social and cultural background of the SCs/STs communities in the State of Goa and shall have a good standing and repute in the society.
- (iii) The panel enlisted in category –A with comprise of adocates having practiced

In compliance to the above directions, a public notice is hereby issued by this office inviting applications from eminent senior Advocates for the empanelment in the South Goa District Panel for conducting cases in Special Courts. The applications shall reach this office within 2 (two) weeks from the date of publication of this notice.

The applications shall be accompanied with all documents in support of eligibility with the above mentioned criteria.
