ORDER

In view of the new SOP for persons travelling to Goa by Road, Rail or Air, the following instructions are hereby issued for strict compliance for all categories of persons entering Goa through **Railways**:

1. The Regional Railway Manager, KRCL, Margao and the Divisional Railway Manager, South Western Railways, Hubli should share their daily Train Schedules with District Administration.
2. Trains should not stop anywhere except their regular designated stations.
3. Any change in schedule of trains should be shared with District Administration.
4. As Soon as train takes a halt at Railway Station, the Police Inspector/Police Sub Inspector posted at Railway Station shall ensure that two Police Constables are placed at the entry or exit door of each coaches. After disembarking of passengers from each coach the concerned Constable shall ensure they are kept in a proper queue by maintaining social distancing and thereafter in sequence they are taken at the special counter.
5. The Self Declaration form is to be filled online and downloaded from Goa Online Portal. The same is to be printed and signed which should be submitted after disembarking from the train at the Railway Station. No person will be allowed to proceed from Railway Station without submission of Self Declaration Form. The hard copies of such Declaration Forms will be made available at the Special Counter established at Railway Platform which shall function round the clock. The special counter shall consist of one Executive Magistrate/Incharge, three Lower Division Clerks/Data Entry Operators, one Cashier, one Paramedic Staff.
6. The residential address and contact number should be compulsory declared by all persons entering into Goa.
7. The paramedic staff shall do thermal screening of the incoming persons and if found symptomatic, refer the person for mandatory testing.
