ORDER

NO. DCD/COVID-19/2020/10458-67

Dated Dimapur 31st of March, 2020

Whereas, in exercise of the powers under Section 6(2)(i) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) has issued Order No. 1-29/2020-PP (Pt-II) dated 24th March, 2020 directing the Ministries/Departments of Government of India, State/Union Territory Governments and State/Union Territory Authorities to take effective measures so as to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the country which has already been declared as a pandemic by the World Health Organization.

And whereas, the State Govt. of Nagaland to initiate effective and immediate measures needed to prevent and contain the spread of COVID-19 has issued order NO.CSO/GAB-1/COM/GEN-1/2020 dated Kohima the 24th march, 2020.

And now therefore, in supersession to the previous orders NO.DEV-4/MEDICAL/2017-D/10385-90 Dated 30th March, 2020 and NO.DEV-4/MEDICAL/2017-D/10385-91 Dated 30th March, 2020 to prevent and contain the spread of COVID-19, I, **Shri Anoop Khinchi, IAS**, Deputy Commissioner, Dimapur in exercise of the power conferred by Section 30(1)(2) under the Disaster Management Act, 2005 do hereby issue the following prohibitory order.

1. All shops, commercial and private establishments shall remain closed.


The above containment measures will remain in force, in all parts of the District, for a period from 06:00 a.m, 1st April, 2020 till 12:00 midnight of 3rd April, 2020.

The order will however be exempted in respect of Police/Army/ Para-military forces/ Magistrate on duty/ Doctors and Medical staff including private hospitals & Clinics, Bank staffs and persons engaged in emergency services.

Any person violating these containment measures will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action under section 188 of the IPC.
