

NO.DEV-4/MEDICAL/2017-D/10385-90 /In exercise of Powers conferred under section 30(1)(2) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and in partial modification to this office order vide NO.DEV-4/MEDICAL/2017-D/10256-60 /Dimapur dated 24th March, 2020, with a view to contain and prevent the spread of Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) and to have more effective monitoring system, all the retail shops selling essential commodities under Dimapur are hereby directed to keep their shops open from 9:00AM-2:00PM only. The shops will remain closed the rest of the time. The general public is also informed to do their shopping at the time period as mentioned above.

However, the pharmacies and medical shops are to remain open from 9 am and remain open as per the normal business hours.

Any person violating this order will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 besides legal action under Section 188 of the IPC.

This order comes w.e.f. 1st April 2020 and will remain in force till further order.


