The registration for Class VI is being done through online portal for which the link is available in the NVS website [www.navodaya.gov.in](http://www.navodaya.gov.in) and [www.nvsadmissionclasssix.in](http://www.nvsadmissionclasssix.in). More than 40 lac students are expected to enroll themselves for appearing in the Navodaya Selection Tests for the year 2020-21 to be conducted on 11th January 2020 and 11th April 2020 for Class VI for Summer, Winter & Extreme Winter Bound JNVs respectively. The last date for filling of online application for both the tests is 15<sup>th</sup> September 2019.

As you are aware, the aspirants for the said tests are from remote localities of the district, concerted efforts to reach out to them are essential without which many deserving and meritorious students may not get the information about the online registration facility.

In this context, I request you to direct the district officials especially the officials of education department to use various platforms under their command to give wide publicity about the online registration for appearing in the JNV Selection Test. Releasing a press note in the district edition of the local newspapers may help immensely to bring instant awareness among the needy students and parents. A DO letter in this regard addressing the Head Masters of Govt. Primary & Upper Primary Schools to extend support & assistance to aspiring class V students to register for Class VI JNVST 2020 may also benefit the deserving rural children. The notification highlighting the important dates and other useful information is placed herewith for your

ready reference. You may direct the district administration to collect the application forms of students who find the submission of online applications difficult and handover to principal, JNV so that the applications will be submitted by JNV on line.

The Principal of Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya has been directed to personally meet you and brief you about the various details concerning JNV Selection Test.

I shall be grateful, if you could kindly monitor the smooth conduct of examination.
