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Subject:-Imposition of restrictions under Section 144 of Cr.PC/DMA Act, 2005 and Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 in District Kulgam.

ORDER

Whereas, threat of Corona Virus and its rapid transmission within the community, requires immediate prevention and speedy remedy to prevent danger to human life, health or safety and;

Whereas, various measures have been taken by the District recently for containment and management of this epidemic diseases as per the powers vested under relevant Section of 144 of Cr.PC, Disaster Management Act, 2005 and the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 in last couple of days;

Whereas, the situation has been reviewed afresh and in light of the obtaining feedback from different stakeholders, it has become expedient to further put in place more stringent measures in consonance with the guidelines issued by Government of India vide above captioned reference;

Now, therefore, in suppression of all previous orders, I Showkat Aijaz Bhat (KAS), District Magistrate, Kulgam, by virtue of powers conferred upon me under the Section 144 Cr.PC, under the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, do hereby order the following restrictions/directions with effect from 12:00 AM on 25/3/2020 till 14/4/2020.

- i. There shall be complete ban on assembly of 2 or more persons for any reason whatsoever;
- ii. That in order to maintain social distancing, the gathering of social/cultural/political/religious/academic/sports/seminars etc shall be completely prohibited coupled with any kind of demonstration, rallies processions and protests;
- iii. That there shall be complete shutdown of all vehicular movement in the district including inter district movement of vehicles except for authorized vehicles including ambulances required for essential purposes;



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iv. That there shall be complete shutdown of all schools, colleges, Gyms, Shops, business markets and establishments including Anganwardi Centres, Hostels within the jurisdiction except establishments for the essential services and supply chains notified vide order No.60-FCS&CA of 2020 dated 22/3/2020 read with addendum to Government order issued vide endorsement No.FSC&CA/Secy/PS/2/2020 dated 23/3/2020. by Department of Food Civil Supply and Consumer Affairs;

v. That to procure/avail essential commodities/services, by the people, in the immediate vicinity of their homes, no more than 3 people can assemble at a particular given time in any authorized establishment strictly following norms of social distancing;

vi. The essential services department shall be allowed on production of passes issued by the District Magistrate. All District Heads of essential services shall operate with lowest minimum manpower in respect of which passes have been issued.


vii. All the Executive Magistrates/SHOs in local jurisdiction well be responsible for implementation of these measures and shall take all precautionary measures while discharging emergency duties.

Any violation of this order by any individual or establishment shall invite action under Indian Penal Code (IPC).

Since it not possible to serve this order individually it shall be circulated in the print/electronic media for information of all concerned.

District Police Kulgam and Revenue authorities are directed to give wide publicity of this order by way of announcement on public address system and by pasting copies of this order at conspicuous places.
