ORDER

Whereas, various orders/circulars/instructions have been issued from time to time by this office with regard to the subject and reference cited above for checking the transmission chain of Coronavirus (COVID-19) infection in District Kulgam, which are well in force;


Whereas, today first COVID-positive case has been detected in District Kulgam who is a resident of Town Kulgam **Reshipora Ward No.04** and has a contact history with a COVID-19 positive case.;

Whereas, the said affected person is residing in town Kulgam Ward **No 04** and there is likelihood of mass contact by this person as he is said to have met many people in the aforementioned Ward due to which the said ward have become more vulnerable for further transmission of COVID-19 virus;

Whereas, in order to break the further transmission chain of COVID-19 infection in the area, it has become imperative to take further stringent precautionary measures like declaring the areas/locations as Red Zones/Containment Zones and their surrounding areas as Buffer Zone;


Now, therefore, in view of the above facts and in the interest of safety and well-being of general public, I, Mr. Showkat Aijaz Bhat, KAS District Magistrate Kulgam in exercise of powers vested in me under Section 144 of Cr.PC, Section 34 of National Disaster Management, Act, 2005 & section 3 of The Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, do hereby order as follows:

1. That the Ward namely **Reshipora Ward No. 04** of Municipal Committee Kulgam is declared as **Red Zone**
2. That other Wards namely **Naikpora-A and B ward No. 02, Noorbagh ward No. 05 and Goripora ward No 03** of Municipal Committee Kulgam are declared as **Buffer Zones**.
3. That there shall be no **inward or outward/villages** movement of any persons from these wards and shall stay at their homes. There shall be a complete lockdown in all Wards viz **Reshipora, Naikpora, Noorbagh and Goripora** of Municipal Committee Kulgam.
4. That there shall be no vehicular movement on the interior roads of town Kulgam
5. Accordingly, Block Medical Officer Kulgam shall, under the supervision of CMO Kulgam, thoroughly conduct the process of



contact-tracing as per the norms including complete survey of 300 Meters of such Ward where this COVID-positive person is residing and has attended religious gatherings and stayed for considerable time. Regular health-screening of the natives of the Wards shall also be ensured.

6. The telephone No.s of COVID-19 Control Room 01931-260156/260388/260416/9419004035/7006494905/9906685127 shall also be widely circulated among the population so that information with regard to suspect cases can be shared by the locals with the health authorities.
7. The Hospital/Institutional Quarantine of the contacts shall be ensured by Medical Superintendent of District Kulgam and Chief Medical Officer Kulgam as per protocol
8. Tehsildar/SHO /TSO of District Kulgam shall ensure supply of essential commodities as per laid down protocols.
9. Any persons/groups/Institutions found violating the directions mentioned supra in this order shall be booked under the relevant provisions of law.
