Whereas, certain measure were put in place from time to time for containment of spread of Coronavirus; and


Whereas, the situation has been revived further and after obtaining feedback from the stakeholders, it has been felt expedient to put in place stringent measures so as to safeguard human life and prevent spread of Coronavirus and break the chain thereof.

Therefore, **I, Showkat Aijaz Bhat (KAS), Chairman District Disaster management Authority/District Magistrate Kulgam, do hereby order that there shall be complete lockdown in the district Kulgam from 23<sup>rd</sup> July to 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2020 except for medical emergencies/essential services.**

Enforcement Agencies are directed to take strict action against anyone found violating these orders.

Any deviation shall attract penal action under section 188 of Indian Penal Code (IPC) read with section 51-56 of Disaster Management Act, 2005 and provisions contained in Epidemic Diseases Act.

Since it is not possible to serve this order individually it shall be circulated in the print, electronic and social media for information of all the concerned.
