Subject:- Restrictions in view of COVID-19 in District Kulgam

ORDER


Whereas, series of orders/communications stand issued by this office under the provisions of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1987, the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and the Criminal Procedure Code to contain and check the spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19) and

Whereas, with the post-lockdown opening of the District, it has been noticed that there has been a considerable increase in the number of COVID positive cases, and a potential threat of spread of infection through public transport, markets and social gatherings etc.

Whereas, the District Administration was constrained to declare 101 areas as Red/Containment Zones.

Therefore, in view of the above, and to contain the spread of infection and as a prophylactic measure, I, Showkat Aijaz Bhat, (KAS) District Magistrate Kulgam, in exercise of powers conferred under Section 144 CrPC and Section 34 of Disaster management Act, hereby order that:

1. All shops and business establishments in the District shall remain closed from 18th of July, 2020 to 24th of July, 2020. The Roster for Operationalization of shops and business establishments notified by this office vide order No.DCK/PA/2020-21/1390-1420 dated 22-06-2020 shall remain suspended.
2. There shall be complete restriction on the movement of Public Transport in the District. Superintendent of Police Kulgam shall ensure the deployment of personnel at prominent Nakas to enforce the restriction of movement of all public transport and seize any vehicle found plying in contravention of this order. The personnel deployed at the Nakas shall facilitate the movement of the following vehicles.
 - a. Ambulances, patients, medical emergency, travelers with valid air tickets.
 - b. Municipal Employees/Health workers/ Employees of Essential Services/ Government Employees working in the District and proceeding towards their official duties, on production of valid Departmental I-cards.
 - c. Vehicles engaged by District Disaster Management Authority Kulgam for COVID-19 containment measures.
 - d. Travelers/residents of the District arriving in the District by Air/Road/Rail.
3. There shall be complete prohibition on all movement from Red/Containment Zones, except for medical emergencies and delivery of essential services to Red/Containment Zones. The concerned Tehsildar and Station House Officer shall be personally responsible for ensuring the directions.
4. Concerned Tehsildars shall ensure the deployment of duty magistrates at all prominent places within their respective jurisdictions. Duty



Magistrates in collaboration with the police personnel shall ensure adherence to the SOPs collaboration with the police personnel shall ensure adherence to the Sops regarding universal usage of face masks as notified by this Office vide order No.DCK/PA/2020-21/1100-1170 dated. 05-06-2020 they shall also ensure strict adherence to the norms of social distancing.

5. The Nodal Officers for supervision of Red/Containment Zones notified by the Officer shall personally monitor the Red Zones assigned, and shall remain in close liaison with the control room (01931-260156, 01931260388, 9419004035) for the necessary.
6. Concerned Tehsildars, Block Medical officers and Station House Officers shall ensure sampling of all vulnerable and immune-comprised people, and Service providers in Red/Containment Zones and of the vulnerable class/areas as notified in the Swasthaya Nidhi data.
7. The livelihood activities viz. works under MGNREGA, Self-Help Groups, Works being executive by the Workers Departments (PDD, R&B, Jal Shakti Department, PMGSY, RDD) shall continue with strict adherence to SOPs on Social Distancing and Universal usage of Masks.
8. It shall be mandatory to wear Face Mask/ Face-covering at all Government offices, private establishments and organizations/ persons dealing with goods and services, public places including public transport, shopping or market places etc. Tehsildar/SHO concerned is hereby authorized to impose fine of Rs.500/- on a person found without Mask in their respective jurisdiction. The Red Cross receipt books shall be made available to concerned and the amount of fine imposed shall be deposited in District Red Cross Society Kulgam.

The situation shall be monitored closely and the orders issued shall be reviewed accordingly.
