Subject:-Covid-19 Containment measures-implementation of lockdown measures.

ORDER

Whereas, keeping in view the surge in the covid-19 +ve cases in the district, restrictions were imposed in the whole districts to arrest the spread of the virus;

Whereas, implementation of new guidelines on keeping asymptomatic +ve case in home quarantine is under way and systems are being put in place for its effective implementation;

Whereas, there has been huge movement of general public in view of relaxation of restrictions for Markets owing to festivals and there are apprehensions of spread of virus which may get aggravated during the early stages of implementation of the new guidelines on Home quarantine of Asymptomatic covid +ve persons;

Whereas, it has been observed that some people are not adhering to the restrictions in place and are still moving around without wearing masks and violating the social distancing norms.;

In view of the above and to control the spread of infection, the restriction already in place are further intensified.


Therefore, I, Showkat Aijaz Bhat (KAS) District Magistrate Kulgam, in exercise of the powers under Sec 144 CrPC and Section 34 of Disaster Management Act 2005, hereby impose the following restrictions from 04/08/2020 to 06/08/2020 with immediate effect:

- 1) There shall be complete Lockdown in whole of the District.
- 2) There shall be complete ban on movement/gathering of more than three (3) persons anywhere in the district.
- 3) There shall be night curfew throughout the District from 9:00 PM to 6:00 AM
- 4) All shops and business establishments shall remain closed in both Urban & Rural areas.
- 5) There shall be complete restrictions on movement of both Public & Private Transport except for Goods/essential supplies vehicles and vehicles of medical personnel & officials dealing with COVID containment measures.

Superintendent of Police Kulgam shall implement the orders in letter & spirit.

Since it is not possible to serve this order individually it shall be circulated in the print, electronic and social media for information of all concerned.
