Subject:- Extension of Corona Curfew in District Doda w.e.f 24/05/2021 (7:00 AM) to 31/05/2021 (7:00 AM).

ORDER

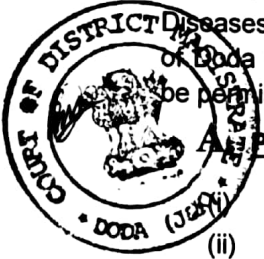
Whereas, the prevailing health situation due to Coronavirus (COVID-19) has effected India and J&K as well; and

Whereas, COVID-19 has pattern of transmission at a rapid pace and public gatherings may become vulnerable for the same; and

Whereas, the District administration has to take effective measures to prevent spread of COVID-19 in District Doda to deal with arising situation; and

Whereas, State Executive Committee (DMRRR) J&K vide Govt. order No:- 31-JK dated:- 22-05-2021 has issued guidelines that the ongoing Corona Curfew in all the 20 district of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir, scheduled to end 7:00AM on 24-05-2021 is extended till 7:00 AM on Monday, 31-05-2021.

Now, therefore, in continuation and amplification to this office order No:- 234-33/DM/Doda dated:- 16-05-2021 I, **Vikas Sharma (KAS), District Magistrate Doda**, in exercise of the power vested in me U/S 144 of Cr.PC. read with Section 34 of Disaster Management Act of 2005 & Section 2 of Epidemic Diseases Act of 1897, do hereby order that the Corona Curfew is extended across the entire jurisdiction of Doda District w.e.f 24-05-2021 (07:00 AM) to 31-05-2021 (07:00AM). Activities and movements shall be permissible as per guidelines detailed below:-



Permissible Activities in entire District.

- Chemist Shops, Diagnostic Centres, Medical, Optical and Clinical Establishments.
- (ii) LPG Outlets and Petrol Pumps.
 - (iii) Agricultural activities including establishments dealing with agricultural inputs, implements and tools/Cattle feed and fodder shops.
 - (iv) ATMs and Cash VANS.
 - (v) Print and electronic media (On production of valid ID Card).
 - (vi) FCI and FC&FCA depots.
 - (vii) Operation and maintenance of telecom towers and other telecom infrastructure (on production of valid ID card).
 - (viii) Ecommerce & Home Delivery of essential goods and services.
 - (ix) Restaurants in hotels for in-house guests, to be served only in the rooms as per SOP.
 - (x) All developmental works & mining activities.
 - (xi) Movement of all Health, Medical & Sanitation personnel (Both Government and Private) on production of ID Cards.
 - (xii) Routine vaccination drive in all designated sites along with additional sites for residential areas.
 - (xiii) Inter District movement of essential goods.
 - (xiv) Officers and officials of UT Government, Government of India, PSUs, Autonomous bodies, Universities, All India Radio, Doordarshan and other such offices on production of ID Cards/ official orders.

B. Partially Permissible Activities in entire District (From 6AM to 10AM only).

- (i) Milk and Dairy products.
- (ii) Bakery, Meat and Chicken Shops.
- (iii) Vendors dealing with Fruits & Vegetables only.
- (iv) Keryana Shops/Stores on alternate days of the week i.e **Wednesday, Friday and Monday.**

C. Non-Permissible Activities in entire District.

- (i) There shall be a complete "Corona" curfew with no movement of people except for permissible activities only, as mentioned above.
- (ii) All Educational institutions including technical & skill development institutes are already closed and shall continue to remain closed.

All Shopping Complexes, Bazaars, Saloons, Barber Shops, Restaurants, Sport Complexes, Gym, Parks, etc, shall remain closed.

D. Other Measures:-

Religious & Social gatherings including marriages at 25 persons only. However, in case of marriages and other pre-planned events, the organizers shall inform the Tehsildar concerned at least 48 Hours in advance and ensure COVID appropriate behavior, No permissions shall be required for such events & the invitation cards shall be treated as movement passes.

District COVID control room (01996-233337, 01996-233465, 01996-233542) shall be operational round the clock to address any of the queries of general public and attend to any exigencies.

Public at large is informed that Section 51 of the Disaster Management Act provides for penalties in case a person obstructs any officer or employee in discharge of his functions or refuses to comply with any direction given under the Act. Any violation of the above directions will, therefore, lead to prosecution under section 51 of DM Act, 2005, Senior Superintendent of Police Doda, shall strictly enforce compliance to this order.

This order shall be widely circulated for information of all by the District, Information Officer Doda.
