Subject:- Restrictions for COVID containment-regarding.

ORDER

Whereas, the prevailing health situation due to Coronavirus (COVID-19) has effected India and J&K as well; and

Whereas, COVID-19 has pattern of transmission at a rapid pace and public gatherings may become vulnerable for the same; and

Whereas, the District administration has to take effective measures to prevent spread of COVID-19 in District Doda to deal with arising situation; and

Whereas, State Executive Committee (DMRRR) J&K vide Govt. order No:- 03- JK (DMRRR) of 2022 dated:- 09-01-2022 has issued guidelines/instructions on COVID containment in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir already notified vide Government Orders 35 and 36-JK (DMRRR) of 2021 dated 29-05-2021 read with Govt. order 73-JK (DMRRR) of 2021 dated:- 22-10-2021, 91-JK (DMRRR) dated:- 28.12.2021 and 02-JK 9DMRRR) of 2022 dated:- 05.01.2022 shall continue to remain in force till further orders.

Now, therefore, I, **Vikas Sharma (JKAS), District Magistrate Doda**, in exercise of the power conferred upon me under Section 34 of Disaster Management Act of 2005, do hereby order that:-

1. A maximum number of people permitted to attend any indoor/outdoor gathering shall be strictly restricted to 25.
2. Restaurants & Gymnasiums are permitted to function at 25% of the authorized capacity with due precautions such as CAB and adherence to SOP.
3. All Colleges, Schools, Polytechnics, ITIs, Coaching Centres for Civil Services/Engineering/NEET etc. to adopt online medium of teaching. There shall be no in-person teaching.
4. Educational institutions shall be permitted to direct attendance of vaccinated staff for administrative purpose only. The Head of the institutions must ensure that guidelines related to social distancing and Covid Appropriate Behavior (CAB) are strictly followed.
5. Night Curfew shall continue to remain on force in District Doda from 09:00 PM to 06:00 AM with complete restriction on non-essential movement.

The Addl. District Magistrate, Bhaderwah, SDM Thathri/Gandoh/Assar and concerned Tehsildars shall strictly ensure that there is full compliance of COVID appropriate behavior under their jurisdiction/areas and in case of any violation, the officers are authorized to impose the penalty/fine against the defaulters.

Any violation of this order shall punitive action including of FIR under relevant provisions of law.

Senior Superintendent of Police, Doda shall ensure the implementation of this order in letter and spirit.
