- II. **Tenderer shall offer components and sub assemblies of specified makes only, wherever specially called for. (However, alternative make(s) may be considered, for which complete technical details for the same duly indicating the techno economical merits and demerits, as compared to make specified shall be furnished in the offer)**

- IV. The successful tender shall purchase branded items from original manufacturer or their authorized dealers only and the proof of purchase shall be produced along with the supply.

1. INTRODUCTION- Sri Kedarnath & Gaurikund are a Holy place, There are so many Pilgrims comes to visit here for worship of God . So that in places a facing lot of crowd , for the safety of peoples and managing the law and order 07 CCTV Cameras installed to Cover main crowded spots i.e. inside of Temple , In/outgoing galleries of main temple at kedarnath & 04 CCTV Cameras at Gaurikund Bus station & holly centers/crowded spots at Gaurikund.

2. This tender is to enter into a contract with one contractor for the “Repairing/Replacing/Updating/installation of existing defaulted Equipments including all types of connecting cables, software etc & Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract for the CCTV System available at Srikedarnath & Gaurikund of Distt. Rudraprayag. For Two years/ Three years.” **Offers from established & reliable contractors with adequate experience in execution of Comprehensive Annual Maintenance contract of CCTV System will only be considered.**

- 1.1 Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract for the IP PTZ/Fix Cameras installed in the following locations shall also cover the maintains of fixing stand, weather proofing arrangement made for the Cables/ cameras , & its power supply arrangement.
- i. Sri Kedarnath -07 cameras (02 PTZ & 05 Fix)
 - ii. Gaurikund- 04 cameras (Fix)
 - iii. Reserve at store- 04 Fix Cameras & 01 Hidden Camera
- 1.2 The CAMC of Monitor, Controller, etc., the contractor shall ensure the proper working of view station software. Up gradation/modification (if any) needed in the above software in future shall be done at free of cost by the contractor with the consent of In-Charge Police Control Room. The CAMC of monitor shall cover all connecting cables etc. The video coming out of all concerning Cameras are viewed in Police Control Room through this monitor only hence the Contractor shall maintain top priority for maintenance of these monitors.
- 1.3 The CAMC of 2KVA online UPS with inbuilt batteries available in Control Room is used to deliver uninterrupted power supply for the CCTV equipments installed in Control Room. Hence the contractor shall maintain high priority for the maintenance of UPS. The CAMC shall also include the rectification/replacement of batteries connected along with UPS.
- 1.4 The CAMC of 1 KVA online UPS with inbuilt batteries available with cameras is used to deliver uninterrupted power supply for the Cameras on failure of mains supply. The CAMC shall also include the rectification/replacement of batteries connected along with UPS.
- 1.5 The CAMC of Core OFC Cable connectivity between the IP/Fix Cameras located at different location and in CCTV Control Room building in Sri Kedarnath and Gaurikund shall include the maintenance of Core OFC cable, UPS, network device/network cable etc., and their power supply arrangements in the camera end and also includes the maintenance of media converter , termination device, network switches etc., and their power supply arrangement available in control room
- 1.6 The contractor shall note that the above core OFC/Fiber cable was laid in cable trenches, and in the underground trenches/overhead laid on pole in open area to cameras location. Hence, the Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract of the above core/OFC cable shall includes rectification of any physical damage

occurring on the OFC by means of splicing, laying of new cables bits and termination of the above etc.

- 1.7 The equipments connected along with the CCTV system (in police control room such as monitor, PC, network device, power arrangement, recording devices, etc.). The contractor shall consider the above system as a whole and shall ensure the proper working the all equipments for obtaining effective control over the CCTV system.
- 1.8 The CAMC shall also include the trouble shooting of any network issues arising in the CCTV network

2. SCOPE OF MAINTENANCE-

- 1- The contractor shall be responsible for maintenance of all equipments mentioned in schedule with a view to provide uninterrupted service of the CCTV System including necessary preventive maintenance, attending to major and minor breakdowns post failure repairs and modifications if any, required for the CCTV system of Sri Kedarnath & Gaurikund .
- 2- The CCTV system at Sri Kedarnath & Gaurikund. is monitored round the clock by our Police Control Room staff. The climate of Sri Kedarnath & Gaurikund remains very cold & Sri Kedarnath is situated at high altitude and can reach after 14 Km on foot journey fm Gaurikund Hence the contractor shall depute only competent . efficient & young staff for routine maintenance as well as to attend the breakdowns to ensure the trouble free working of CCTV system. Sri Kedarnath & Gaurikund well in time.
- 3- The service personnel deputed by the contractor shall be well qualified, possessing Engineering Degree/ Diploma certificate holder and having enough knowledge in the field of CCTV System. The list of service personnel along with their qualifications, experience and age shall be enclosed along with the tender document with proper proof. Without fulfilling these conditions, the offer of the contractor shall be treated as disqualified.
- 4- Contractor shall furnish to the Police Department, the Name, Address and Telephone Number of the engineer responsible for the maintenance work. Name and telephone Number of Engineer who can be contacted after office hours and Sunday/ Holidays shall also be furnished to Police Department.
- 5- Contractor shall provide ID Cards to their engineers and staff authorized to attend the maintenance work so as to facilitate verification by representative of Police Department. Communication handed over to the contractor's personal at site / office shall deem to have reached their office.
- 6- At the end of each major breakdown repair, contractor's Engineer should prepare a service report and submit the same to the office of SP **Rudraprayag**/In-Charge Police Control Room.
- 7- All the tools and testing instruments required for checking testing and attending to routine maintenance and breakdowns shall be arranged by the contractor.
- 8- **The preventive Maintenance shall be carried out once in a month.** The contractor shall undertake arrangements for preventive maintenance of CCTV System every month. In addition to the preventive maintenance the contractor shall attend break down calls whenever emergency arises and there will be no limit for such calls.
- 9- The components of the equipment will be the sole responsibility of contractor for procurement and replacement as and when required during the period of CAMC.
- 10- The contractor's staff will carry the routine spares required for preventive maintenance to ensure minimum down time without any additional cost. In addition to those spares contractor will also arrange other spares if required without any additional charges.
- 11- Breakdown call shall be attended with a time frame after getting the message by phone or fax of failure. If the repair is major contractor shall provide standby equipment at contractor cost.

- 12- In case of major repairs necessitating removal of the equipment to the contractors service centre, the system or its parts shall be reinstalled at the owner premises after repairing the set in working condition. Provision of standby camera comes under the scope of contract.
- 13- Trained and supervisory police control staff shall be permitted to minor urgent changes if required for which suitable log will be maintained by police control room staff.
- 14- A log book will be maintained in the CCTV room in which day to day failures and problems notices shall be entered and informed to the contractor indicating date and time. The contractor's Engineer/representative has to fill up the log book as per schedule maintenance check up giving the details as well as corrective measures taken by the contractors engineers with date and time
- 15- All remedial maintenance of the equipments and its preventive maintenance required periodically shall be provided by the contractor. Such maintenance comes under the scope of contractor. Supply of and fitment of all parts including consumable will need replacement from time to time with understanding that replaced part immediately will become police property and the part removed will become contractor's property with condition that the contractor shall use new and unused except those parts which can be reused after required servicing.
- 16- The contractors shall ensure that the full configuration of the equipment is in proper working condition, after repair and maintenance.
- 17- All minor repairs/services should be made only at Police control room premises. As far as possible no equipment will be sent to the contractor's premises for any repair. If at all, it is found necessary to take the equipment to the contractor's premises, the configuration of the equipment in details must be got noted before it is sent out. The items will be taken out only with proper documentation such as materials gate passes and with proper acknowledgements. All endeavors will be made by the contractor to return such items taken out for servicing within a reasonable period of one week. Stand by equipment similar to the equipment under service to be provided before taking it out on material gate pass, till the original component is replaced **AT NO EXTRA COST**. The contractor is required to record all such issues, returns / replacements of equipment promptly.
- 18- In any case where the equipment could not be rectified / replaced by the firm within the reasonable time, Police Department reserves the right to get the equipment repaired / replaced through an other agency at the risk and cost of the contractor. The contractor will have to bear expenses incurred by the Police Department on this account. This action will be taken if the equipment is neither rectified/ replaced nor any stand-by is provided even after the reasonable time.
- 19- Taking shelter under flimsy reasons such as damage could have been caused by rat bite, power outage, rough handling on the part of the user and similar such reasons, and failing to provide maintenance / replacement support will not be acceptable.
- 20- Complete hardware and software support to be extended by the contractor.
- 21- Carrying any software changes if required without additional charges with the consent of **In-Charge Police Control CCTV/ SP Rudraprayag.**
- 22- In case of odd hour's failures and emergencies even on holidays and Sundays normal service is to be rendered by the contractor.
- 23- The Contractor shall ensure that the equipment is in good working condition and is with full configuration while handing over at the end of the contract period.

3. PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE:

- a Regular preventive maintenance visits shall be made by the firm ONCE IN A MONTH to ensure up keep of the system. Any fault brought to the firm's notice either during such routine calls or otherwise informed by Control Room officials, shall be arranged to be responded as earlier.
- b. The preventive maintenance of the system should be carried out in the presence of the Control room staff. The preventive maintenance of the CCTV System includes cleaning all the equipments, checking the individual / complete performance of equipments of the CCTV System.
- c. The contractor shall ensure the proper working of recording of the video obtained from the CCTV cameras and necessary backup has to be taken in the form of **DVD/ CD** in the regular interval as instructed by SP/ concerned In charge of OPs. The provision of **DVD/CD** shall be in the scope of work of tender.
- d. The service engineer of the contractor attending to the maintenance shall monitor the environment in which the hardware is working and forewarn the control room in charge of any factor discreditable to the satisfactory performance of the hardware.
- e A schedule for preventive maintenance shall be drawn by the contractor and submitted to the control room in charge well in advance. It will be in such a manner that all the equipment falling within the preview of the contract is covered in a systematic manner.
- f. A separate log book shall be maintained for recording preventive maintenance and put up to the concerned I/C monthly.

4. SITE OF WORK

The intending tenderer is advised to study the tender documents, concerned specifications and other instructions carefully. The tenderer shall inspect the proposed site of work and acquaint him/ themselves with the site conditions, working hours and all relevant items connected with execution of work. The submission of tender shall be deemed to have been done after careful study and examination of the tender papers with full understanding of the implications thereof.

The contractor shall offer the units for inspection after periodical maintenance / Service/ Repair to an authorized representative of **SP Rudraprayag** and also get a report signed by the **concerned Control Room** in charge with office seal before submission of bill for quarterly payment from **SP Rudraprayag**.

2. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT:

a. The Tenderer shall pay Earnest Money Deposit as per **above** of Tender Notice placed in Page – 3 of this tender document, either in the form of a Crossed Demand Draft/ Fixed Deposit Receipt drawn in favor of **SP Rudraprayag**. Shall be submitted along with the Quotation. Quotations received with out E.M.D. as stipulated above, shall be Liable for rejection and No correspondence shall be entertained in this connection.

b. Fixed Deposit Receipts/ Pay Orders or Demand Drafts from nationalized banks (or) schedule banks submitted by the tenderer should be drawn in favor of **SP Rudraprayag**.

c. FDR's drawn in the name of the tenderer with the endorsement of the concerned bank on the overleaf of the FDR transferring the right of encashment to the **Police Department** will not be accepted.

d. No interest will be payable upon the Earnest Money and Security Deposit or amounts payable to the Contractor under the Contract.

3. PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE CERTIFICATE

Bidders will attach the work orders of same type works in other organizations in this support.

4. SECURITY DEPOSIT:

4.1 The security deposit/ rate of recovery/ Mode of recovery shall be as under –

(a) Security deposit for each work should be 5% of the contract value.

(b) The rate of recovery should be at the rate of 10% of the bill amount till the full security deposit is recovered.

(c) Security deposit will be recovered only from the running bills of the contract and no other node of collecting SD such as SD in the form of instruments like BG, FD Etc.

4.2 Alternatively, the earnest money deposited by the successful contractor shall be retained by the **Uttarakhand Police** as a part of the security deposit and the balance amount if any to make up security deposit, shall be recovered by percentage deduction from the contractor's "On account bills" .

4.3 The security deposit would be returned to the contractor after the satisfactory completion of the work and maintenance / guarantee period is completed based on “No claim certificate” issued by the concerned authorities.

5- PERIOD OF Repairing Work ; The Repairing/Replacing/Updating / installation of existing defaulted equipments must be completed within “**10 days from the date of awarding Tender at Gaurikund & before opening of Mandir Kapat at Sri Kedarnath.**”

6. PERIOD OF CAMC; The period of comprehensive annual maintenance contract is for a period of “**Two/ three years from the date of issue letter ”.**

7. COMPLETION REPORT; On completion of entire work, The contractor shall submit a completion certificate countersigned by the supervisor under whose direct inspection the work has been carried out.

8.TERMS OF PAYMENT; No advance payment will be made against this contract.

8.1 Payment at the end of every quarter will be arranged. Based on the successful completion of the preventive and breakdown maintenance for the respective period.

8.2 Penalties imposed during a quarter shall be deducted from the quarterly payment due to the contractor.

8.3 In case the contractor fails to maintain due to any reason no payment will be made. However all penalty on the contractor shall continue as per penalty clause to be liable even after termination of the contract and same shall be deducted from any other bill or security deposit due to contractor.

9. PENALTY CLAUSE -

In case the guaranteed repair time not being met, the following penalty shall be lived.
