Subject:- Imposition of Night Curfew (Corona curfew) in Urban areas of District Kathua from 10pm to 6am- regarding.

Reference:- J&K Government Order No 16-JK(DMRRR) of 2021 dated 08.04.2021.

ORDER

Whereas, recent spike has been reported in daily COVID-19 positive cases in the district and this spread of COVID-19 pose threat to public life in general;

Whereas, the Government of Jammu and Kashmir Department of Disaster Management, Relief, Rehabilitation & Reconstruction State Executive Committee Civil Secretariat, Jammu vide Order No. **16-JK(DMRRR) of 2021 dated 08.04.2021** issued under endorsement No. DMRRR/PS/Secy/551/2020 dated. 08.04.2021, has issued guidelines for implementation of the curfew from 10 pm to 6 am at night in urban areas and shall be enforced within the municipal limits/ limits of the urban local bodies of this district w.e.f 09-04-2021; and

Now, therefore, I, **Rahul Yadav, IAS**, District Magistrate, Kathua, vide powers conferred upon me under Section- 144 of CrPC and under Section 24 of the Disaster Management Act 2005, hereby orders that the curfew from 10 pm to 6 am at night in urban areas in this district and shall be enforced within the municipal limits/ limits of the urban local bodies of this district w.e.f 09-04-2021. It is clarified that the passengers coming via trains shall not be affected by the above restriction.

Since, it is not possible to serve prior notice of this order, it is as such being issued ex-parte and addressed to public in general. Provided that this order shall not apply to police or paramilitary force or any person on lawful government duty.

Any violation of this order shall invite punitive action under Section 188 of Indian Penal Code and the Disaster Management Act 2005.
