Order No. 126/MA

WHEREAS, in exercise of powers conferred under Section 144 of CRPC the undersigned had vide order no. 54/MA dated: 23.03.2020 imposed curfew in the entire district till further orders for the containment and prevention of the spread of COVID-19.

WHEREAS, vide order no. 86/MA dated: 31.03.2020, order no. 97/MA dated: 05.04.2020, order no. 104/MA dated: 09.04.2020 and order no. 111/MA dated: 11.04.2020 certain exemptions were granted.

WHEREAS, as per para 4 of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India guidelines dated: 15.04.2020, states could impose stricter measures than these guidelines, as per requirements of local areas.

Now, THEREFORE, I, Ghanshyam Thori, IAS, District Magistrate, Sangrur in exercise of powers conferred under Section 144 of CRPC hereby order that in keeping in view the emergent nature and potential magnitude of the pandemic and for the purpose of ensuring health and safety of human life by enforcing measures - the curfew imposed in the District shall remain in force as such. Any exemptions granted previously and not revoked shall remain as such. No fresh exemption is being granted through this order. Any specific exemptions to be granted by this office shall be determined on the basis of the objectives of essential nature of the activity, the mitigation of hardship to the public and ensuring continuity of Government business on case to case basis separately.

Any violation shall invite criminal proceedings under the relevant provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and the Indian Penal Code, 1860.
