TO WHOMSOEVER IT MAY CONCERN

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF), Government of India's letter No-11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2006 ('FRA' for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MOEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MOEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it certified that area 1.335 Hec, 1.502 Hec, 1.097 Hec, 2.044 Hec, 0.663 Hec, 1.249 Hec & 0.938 Hec of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Jharkhand Bijili Vitran Nigam Ltd. for Construction of 33 KV Line in Hazaribagh District falls within jurisdiction of Giddi, Basariya, Baskudra, Hesalaong, Napo, Hosir & Dadi in villages Dadi tehsils.

It is further certified that:

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 1.335 Hec, 1.502 Hec, 1.097 Hec, 2.044 Hec, 0.663 Hec, 1.249 Hec & 0.938 Hec of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee (s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure 1 to annexure 3.
- (b) The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/ local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA;
- (c) The each of concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified that all formalities/processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the gram sabha of Giddi, Basariya, Baskudra, Hesalaong, Napo, Hosir & Dadi in Dadi villages is enclosed as annexure 1 "A" to annexure 1 "D"
- (d) The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present;
- (e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their consent to it;

The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1) (e) of the FRA
