**Subject: - COVID-19 Containment Measures and Imposition of Night Curfew (Corona Curfew) Under Section 144 CrPC In Urban Areas of District Srinagar.**

**ORDER**

Whereas, due to spike in the number of reported COVID-19 positive cases in District Srinagar and on the basis of risk perception of Health Department, the State Executive Committee vide Government Order No: 10-JK (DMRRR) of 2021, dated: 30.03.2021 classified District Srinagar as "Orange Zone".

Whereas, the State Executive Committee of Department of Disaster Management Relief Rehabilitation and Reconstruction vide Government Order No. 16-JK (DMRRR) of 2021 Dated 08.04.2021 has issued guidelines/instructions regulating activities within the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir for effective containment of Covid-19 w.e.f 9<sup>th</sup> April 2021.


Whereas, as per Para 2 (a) of J&K Government Order No. 16-JK (DMRRR) of 2021 Dated 08.04.2021 "Corona Curfew shall be imposed from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM in Urban Areas of eight districts affected by the recent COVID spike, requiring District Magistrates to issue specific prohibitory orders in this regard under section 144 of CrPC".

Therefore, in view of above facts and circumstances, I, **Mohammad Aijaz (IAS), District Magistrate (Chairman DDMA) Srinagar**, in exercise of powers vested in me under section 144 of CrPC, Disaster Management Act and Epidemic Diseases Act, do hereby impose Corona Curfew during night and extend complete restrictions on the movement of people from 10:00 P M to 06:00 A M w.e.f 09.04.2021 within Municipal Limits of Srinagar city, till further orders. Essential services, cases of extreme urgency/medical emergency and movement of essential goods are exempted. As such, these restrictions shall not be applicable to essential services including plying of Ambulances, Health and Sanitation Workers, Fire Tenders, Jal Shakti, PDD Employees etc. subject to production of valid identity cards.

Since, it is not possible to serve prior notice of this order, it is as such being issue ex-parte. Any violation of this order shall invite punitive action under section 188 of Indian Penal Code and other relevant sections of Epidemic Disease Act 1897 and the Disaster Management Act 2005.

Senior Superintendent of Police Srinagar shall ensure implementation of these restrictions in letter and spirit.

This order shall be widely circulated for information of all by the Director, Information and Public Relations.
