## ORDER


WHEREAS, a letter has been received from Superintending Engineer, HPPWD vide letter no. PW-SE-VIII/WA-1/Roads/2020-21-1524-25 dated 21<sup>st</sup> May, 2021 requesting for ex-post sanction regarding procurement of material/works for civil as well as specialized nature work in designated COVID hospital at district Headquarter on emergent basis.

Further, seeing the COVID situation in the second wave and in recognition of the fact that in order to ensure urgent creation of healthcare facilities for COVID patients or any other aspects of COVID management there may be a need to invoke the provisions of Section 50 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 for any emergency procurement. Hence, as per the recommendation of the Superintending Engineer, HPPWD a work execution committee for such cases where section 50 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 is involved shall be as under:

1.	Superintending Engineer HPPWD, Hamirpur	Chairman
2.	Chief Medical Officer, Hamirpur	Member
3.	Sub Divisional Magistrate, Hamirpur	Member
4.	Dy. Superintendent of Police, Hamirpur	Member
5.	Executive Engineer, Jal Shakti Vibhag, Hamirpur	Member
6.	Executive Engineer, HPSEBL, Hamirpur	Member
7.	Executive Engineer PWD Mechanical, Hamirpur	Member
8.	Assistant Controller (F&A), Hamirpur	Member


In any such case where the emergency procurement clause is required to be invoked for the creation of healthcare infrastructure for COVID management, the same shall be done with the prior approval of the District Authority.

In such cases of extreme emergency pertaining to COVID-19, the aforementioned committee shall:

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- i. be governed by the Section 50(1) of Disaster Management Act, 2005 and is authorized to make emergency procurement with prior intimation to district administration and in such case, the standard procedure requiring inviting of tenders shall be deemed to be waived for the fastest execution of the work;
  - ii. be authorized to invite/accept and finalize proposals from any vendor, market survey or any other mean(part or in whole) and do all the necessary requirement/arrangements for set up of the proposed makeshift hospital and get the same executed in a shortest possible time-span;

- iii. allot work on the basis of minimum market prevailing rates and on fastest execution basis;
- iv. carve out the necessary requirements for setting up of a makeshift Dedicated Covid Health Centre as per the standard protocol of Ministry of Health and Family welfare.


