## **ORDER**

In compliance to order no. Rev (DMC) (C) 20-2/2021-COVID 19-III, Dated 02<sup>nd</sup> July, 2021, issued by the Chief Secretary-cum-Chairperson, State Executive Committee, Himachal Pradesh and in partial amendment to this office order no. DCH/RELIEF/DMC/2021-1462 , Dated 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2021, I, Debasweta Banik (IAS), District Magistrate, Hamirpur (Himachal Pradesh) in exercise of the powers conferred in me under section 33 & 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, do hereby order and direct that:

1. Maximum number of the persons allowed to congregate in recruitment rallies/drives by the Army, Paramilitary, Forces, Police and Forest shall be relaxed subject to adherence with COVID-19 appropriate behavior and safety protocols during these rallies.
2. For social/ academic/ sports/ entertainment/ cultural/ religious and other congregations in indoor built up/covered areas, a maximum gathering of 50% of the capacity will be allowed, with a ceiling of maximum 150 persons. Wearing of face masks, maintaining social distancing, provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash or sanitizer will be mandatory at all such venues.
3. In open spaces, social/ academic/ sports/ entertainment/ cultural/ religious and other congregations will be allowed with ceiling of maximum 250 persons. Above restrictions are subject to strict adherence with COVID-19 appropriate behavior and social distancing. Wearing of face masks, maintaining social distancing, provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash or sanitizer will be mandatory at all such venues.

Compliance to this order shall be ensured by the Superintendent of Police, Hamirpur, all the Sub-Divisional Magistrates, Head of Departments, Executive Magistrates, Block Development Officers, and PRIs in Hamirpur District.

Any person violating these measures will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51-60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action under Section 188 of the IPC, and other legal provisions as applicable.

THIS order shall come into force with immediate effect in the entire territorial jurisdiction of Hamirpur district and shall remain valid till further orders.
