ORDER

Whereas, a sudden spike in the number of COVID-19 cases has been noticed in the past 2 weeks in district, and due to increase, there is likelihood that patients may require special medical care and hospitalization.

Therefore, I, Debasweta Banik (IAS), District Magistrate, Hamirpur (Himachal Pradesh) in exercise of the powers conferred in me under section 33 and 34 of the Disaster Management Act-2005 do hereby order and direct that;

1. In view of the rise in positive cases, all the DCCCs and DCHCs shall be kept in readiness. The Principal, Dr. RKGMC, Hamirpur and Chief Medical Officer shall ensure to prepare the duty roster of doctors and other paramedical staff for any emergency. The concerned Nodal Officers of DCCC/DCHC/DCH should also be fully prepared.
2. District Ayurveda Officer should remain prepared to vacate the District Ayurvedic building/DCHC on a 24 hour notice, so as to operationalize the DCHC as and when required.
3. The Chief Medical Officer and Principal, Dr. RKGMC are directed to ensure that consumables such as Medicines, PPE Kits, Gloves, Oxygen Cylinders etc. be stocked up. In case of any shortfall, demand may be raised immediately under intimation to this office.
4. The CMO and Principal, Dr. RKGMC shall prepare inventory of all oxygen related supplies such as oxygen cylinders (D-type, B-type), oxygen concentrators, oxygen flowmeters/ regulators etc. and other essential Covid related supplies and communicate it to this office by 16.08.2021 positively.
5. Nodal Officers for Ambulances (CMO Office)/ MS, Dr. RKGMC to mobilize all ambulances especially the ones for Covid puposes and share the deployment plan of these ambulances with this office by 16.08.2021 positively.
6. All PHC/CH/CHC should have separate earmarked beds for isolation of Covid patients/suspected Covid patients along with oxygen support for urgent use and for use during waiting time for ambulances.
7. The CMO to ensure mapping of Home Isolated patients with the MOs of the concerned PHC and ensure regular follow up of these patients through calls and visits by the concerned Doctors/ Asha workers. The report regarding this be submitted on daily basis to the undersigned.

8. AAYUSH doctors earlier deputed in Covid Helpline number established in the DDMA cell of the DC office are directed to report back on duty w.e.f 13.08.2021 in view of increase in number of cases.

9. In view of the directions recieved from the Secretary Health, the HPPWD department and Dr. RKGMC to ensure that all arrangements are put in place for the proposed make shift hospital immediately.
