ORDER UNDER SECTION 34 OF THE DISASTER MANAGEMENT ACT 2005

WHEREAS, recent mutation of SARS-CoV-2 variant (B.1.1.529; named Omicron) has been reported from South Africa on 24th November, 2021 and subsequently Covid positive cases of the same variant has been reported from various States of the Country including Himachal Pradesh;

WHEREAS, the there are reports of sharp rise in the number of Covid-19 positive patients in the district which has necessitated to take some precautionary measures on emergent basis;

WHEREAS, the Chief Secretary-cum- Chairman, State Executive Committee, Himachal Pradesh vide his office order no. Rev (DMC) (C) 20-2/2022- COVID-19, Dated 05th January, 2022 has imposed certain restrictions in the State in order to restrict the spread of Covid -19;

THEREFORE, I, Mrs. Debasweta Banik (I.A.S), Chairperson, District Disaster Management Authority-cum-District Magistrate, Hamirpur (H.P) in compliance to the directions passed by the Chief Secretary-cum-Chairman, State Executive Committee, Himachal Pradesh and in welfare of the public at large and in exercise of the powers vested in me under section 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 do hereby order and direct that:

1. "No Mask-No Service" policy will remain operational in the district.
2. There shall be Night Curfew in the district from 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM. However movement of essential goods,vechiles or any person engaged in essential services or any other emergency purpose shall not be hindered.
3. In all indoor/covered areas and open spaces including marriage palaces & banquet halls, social/academic/sports/entertainment/cultural/political/ religious and other congregations are allowed with 50% of the capacity subject to adherence with the COVID-19 safety protocols and COVID appropriate behaviour in the district.
4. Hotels & Restaurants shall remain open subject to strict adherence to COVID-19 appropriate behaviour and safety protocols in the district.
5. Cinema Halls/ Multiplex/ Sports Complex/ Stadiums/ Swimming Pools/ Gymnasiums shall remain closed in the district till further order.
6. No langar shall be allowed in all religious places/places of worship of in this district.

COMPLIANCE to this order shall be ensured by the Superintendent of Police, Hamirpur, all Sub Divisional Magistrates, Hamirpur, Chief Medical Officer, Hamirpur, all Executive Magistrates, Hamirpur, all Block Medical Officers, Hamirpur and public at large. Violation of the order shall attract provisions of section 51-60 of Disaster Management Act, 2005 and the violator shall be prosecuted accordingly.
