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The Govt. in the ref. 5th cited accorded permission on the following for implementation of the Kanti Velugu programme as follows.

1. To Outsource 400 PMOAs on hiring basis through APCOS for a period of 1 year for implementation of Dr. YSR Kanti Velugu Programme in 13 Districts of State as per the duties assigned **w.e.f 1.12.2020 to 30.11.2021 @ Rs. 15,000/- PM per PMOA.**
2. To incur the expenditure towards remuneration from the budget allocated under NPCB activities under NHM.

Hence as per the orders issued in GO 1st cited and in Govt. Circular 3rd cited, the DM&HOs / DPMs (DBCS) is requested to engage the Outsourcing services of 400 PMOAs through District Selection Committee duly following the guidelines for Outsourcing services through APCOS as follows.

I) The Qualification and eligibility criteria for the post of PMOA is as follows:

- A) Intermediate with MPC / BIPC as basic Academic Qualification with
 - i) Paramedical Ophthalmic Assistants course from Institute recognized by the Govt. of A.P (or)
 - ii) B.Sc., (Optometry) Course from Institute recognized by the Govt. of A.P. (or)
 - iii) Diploma in Optometric technician from Institute recognized by the Govt. of A.P. (or)
 - iv) Diploma in Optometry from Institute recognized by Govt. of A.P.
- B) The Candidate must be registered in AP paramedical Board.
- C) Age shall be between 18-42 years as on 1.12.2020.

The selection committee should follow the guidelines issued in the GO. 1st cited, if number of application received are more than the no. of vacancies, the selection shall be made on based on merit for the selection of Para Medical Staff, out of a total of 100 marks, 45 marks shall be allotted against the marks obtained in the academic qualification, 45 marks shall be allotted against the marks obtained in Technical qualification under 10 marks for weight age from the date of passing technical examination @ mark per year.

II) The **following District Selection Committee** is hereby proposed as per the Guidelines issued in Govt. Circular Memo NO. GAD 01 - SUOMISC / 31 / 2019 - SU-1, dated. 20.11.2019.

1. **Chairperson** - District Collector and Ex-Officio Exe. Director of APCOS.
2. **Member- Convener** - Joint Collector - II
3. **Member** - DM&HO of the Concern District (Representative of the Indenting Organization).

The **DM&HO is the Nodal Officer** for smooth conduct of entire process of Outsourcing of PMOAs. The DPM (DBCS) is requested to coordinate and provide necessary support for smooth completion of the task.

The DM&HOs / DPMs shall follow the following Timelines for processing and selection of KV PMOAs for early completion of Phase-III screening programme.

The District Collectors of the Districts are requested to monitor the entire process of Outsourcing of the services of PMOAs under Dr. YSR Kanti Velugu.


