

## 1. MOOVALUR RAMAMIRTHAM AMMAIYAR NINAIVU MARRIAGE ASSISTANCE SCHEME

- 1.Name of the Scheme: Moovalur Ramamirtham Ammaiyar Ninaivu Marriage Assistance Scheme
- 2.Objectives of the Scheme : To provide assistance to poor parents in getting their daughters married and to promote the educational status of poor girls.
- 3.Assistance provided : **Scheme –I** Rs.25,000/- ( through ECS) +8 grams gold ( 1 sovereign ) gold coin 22 carat is provided for making „Thirumangalyam.  
**Scheme-II** Rs.50,000./- ( through ECS) + 8 grams gold ( 1 sovereign) 22 carat gold coin for making „Thirumangalyam
- 4.To whom the benefit is due to be given : The benefit will be given in the name of mother or father , In case of death of the parents it will be given to the bride.

- 5.Eligibility Criteria
- a)Educational Qualification
- 1. The bride should have studied 10th Std (passed or failed)
  - 2. If studied in private / distance education bride should have passed 10th std
  - 3. Bride should have studied up to V Std in case of Scheduled Tribe

### Scheme-2

- 1. Degree Holders from regular colleges, Distance Education / Government recognized Open University are eligible.
  - 2. Diploma holders should have qualified from Institutions recognized by the Directorate of Technical Education, Government of Tamil Nadu.
- b) Income limit Not exceeding Rs.72,000/- per annum for the family
- c) Age limit Bride should have completed 18 years of age at the time of marriage. There is no upper age limit.
- d) Other criteria Only one girl from a family is eligible

1.Name of the Scheme: Dr. Dharmambal Ammaiyar Ninaivu Widow Remarriage Assistance Scheme

2.Objectives of the Scheme : To encourage widow remarriage and to rehabilitate widows.

3.Assistance provided : **Scheme –I** Rs.25,000./ - (Rs.15000/- by ECS & Rs.10,000/- as National Saving Certificate) along with 8 grams (1 sovereign) 22 carat is provided for making „Thirumangalyam.

**Scheme-II** Rs. 50,000./- (Rs.30,000/- by ECS and Rs.20,000/- National Saving Certificate) + 8 grams (1 sovereign) 22 carat gold coin for making Thirumangalyam

4.To whom the benefit is due to be given : Widow who remarries.

### 3. E.V.R MANIAMMAIYAR NINAIVU MARRIAGE ASSISTANCE SCHEME FOR DAUGHTERS OF POOR WIDOWS

1.Name of the Scheme: E.V.R.Maniammaiyar Ninaivu Marriage Assistance Scheme for Daughters of Poor Widows.

2.Objectives of the Scheme : To help the poor widows who face financial hardship in conducting their daughter's marriage by providing assistance for the marriage of their daughters.

3.Assistance provided : **Scheme –I** Rs.25,000/- by ECS + 8 grams (1 sovereign) 22 carat gold coin is provided for making „Thirumangalyam  
**Scheme-II**Rs.50,000./- by ECS + 8 grams (1 sovereign) 22 carat gold coin is provided for making Thirumangalyam.

4.To whom the benefit is due to be given : To the bride's widowed mother. The benefit can be given to the bride in case of death of the applicant.

5.Eligibility Criteria **Scheme-1**

a)Educational Qualification

- Education qualification not required

#### **Scheme-2**

- 1. Degree Holders from regular colleges, Distance education / Government recognized Open University.
- 2. The Diploma holders should have qualified from an Institution recognized by the Directorate of Technical Education, Government of Tamil Nadu.

b) Income limit

Annual income of the family should not exceed Rs.72,000/-

c) Age limit >

Bride should have completed 18 years of age at the time of marriage. There is no upper age limit.

d) Other criteria

Only one daughter of the poor widow is eligible

2. Objectives of the Scheme : To abolish caste and community feelings based on birth and wiping out discrimination by encouraging inter-caste marriage.
3. Assistance provided the form of National Savings Certificate) +8 grams (1 sovereign) 22 carat gold coin is provided for making „Thirumangalyam
- Scheme –I** Rs.25,000/- (Rs.15,000/- by ECS and Rs.10,000/- in form of National Savings certificate.) +8 grams (1 sovereign) 22 carat gold coin is provided for making „Thirumangalyam
- Scheme-II** Rs.50,000./- (Rs.30,000 by ECS and Rs.20,000 in the form of National Savings certificate.) +8 grams (1 sovereign) 22 carat gold coin is provided for making „Thirumangalyam.
4. To whom the benefit is due to be given : Inter caste married couple.
- The following two categories of inter-caste marriages can avail benefits :-
- **Category I** The assistance is provided to newly married couples of whom one spouse should be from Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe and the other from a different Community.
  - **Category II** The assistance is provided to a newly married couple of whom one spouse is from other community (forward community) and the other from the Backward Class / Most Backward Class Community.

## 6. CHIEF MINISTER GIRL CHILD PROTECTION SCHEME

- 1.Name of the Chief Minister Girl Child Protection Scheme. Scheme- I for one Girl Child Scheme- II for two Girl Children  
Scheme: Promoting education of girl children, eradicating female infanticide, discouraging the preference for male child, promoting the small family norm, promoting the welfare of girl children in poor families and to raise the status of girl children.
- 2.Objectives of the Scheme : Under **Scheme-I** : Rs.50.000/-\* Fixed Deposit in the name of girl child for the family which has only one girl child Under **Scheme-II** Fixed Deposit for Rs.25000/- \* for each girl child where the family has two girl children only Interest amount shall be given annually to the girl child from the sixth year of the deposit and upto 20th year of deposit for her educational purpose.
- 3.Assistance provided : 4.To whom the benefit is due to Girl children in poor families be given :
- 5.When the On completion of 20 years of deposit, the balance accrued interest with benefit is due the deposit amount will be paid
- 6.Eligibility Criteria  
a)Income Limit Family income should be below Rs.72,000/- per annum .  
b) Other Criteria Either of the parents should have undergone sterilization within 35 years of age. Family should have only one/two female children and no male child. In future, Male child should not be adopted in future.  
c) Time limit for Application should be made before the girl child completes 3 years of age for Scheme-I. For Scheme-II application should be made before the second girl child completes 3 years of age.

  - 2. Parents age proof (Birth certificate/ school certificate/Government doctor's certificate)
  - 3. Sterilization certificate (Government / private hospital)

  - 6. Nativity certificate from the Tahsildar (The parents/ grand parents should be a domicile of Tamil Nadu for a period of 10 years at the time of submitting the application)

- i. After completion of 5th year of deposit the beneficiary should approach the District Social Welfare Officer /Extension Officer (SW)/Rural Welfare Officer (Women) with bank details, educational details of the children.
  - ii. Annual incentive of Rs.1,800/- will be given as educational assistance from the beginning of the sixth year of the fixed deposit.
- 10.Final Maturity The matured amount will be given to the girl child only if she appears for 10th standard public exam. If not, it will be remitted into Government account.

## 7. SATHIYAVANI MUTHU AMMAIYAR NINAIVU FREE SUPPLY OF SEWING MACHINE SCHEME

1.Name of the Scheme: Sathiyavani Muthu Ammaiyar Ninaivu Free Supply of Sewing Machine Scheme

2.Objectives of the Scheme : Sewing Machines are supplied free of cost with a view to increase the self employment potential for rehabilitation of destitute women/widows, deserted wives, differentlyabled men and women, socially affected women and women from economically weaker sections.

4.To whom the benefit is due to be given : Destitute women/widows, deserted wives, differentlyabled men and women, socially affected women and woman from economically weaker sections.
