O R D E R S

Imphal, the 10th January, 2021

No. DC(IW)/1/CON/361/02: Whereas, it has been reported that 1 (one) resident of Tera Yengkhom Leirak, Imphal West District, is tested COVID-19 positive and in view of the impending threat of COVID-19 pandemic in the area, it has become expedient to issue containment measures to prevent the spread of the disease in the area;

Now, therefore, I, Naorem Praveen Singh, Deputy Commissioner of Imphal West District, Manipur, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Para 12 of "The Manipur Epidemic Diseases, COVID - 19 Regulations, 2020" and in pursuance of the advisory of the Director General of Health Services (EMR Division), Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India in regard to containment of COVID - 19, do hereby declare the following containment measures in the geographical area mentioned in the schedule with immediate effect:

- 1) Sealing of the geographical area.
- 2) Entry and exit of population from the containment area.
- 3) Closure of schools, offices, if any and banning public gathering of any type.
- 4) Banning vehicular movement in the area.
- 5) Initiating active surveillance of COVID - 19 cases.
- 6) Compulsory use of Aarogya Setu application by all the people staying/residing within the containment area.

SCHEDULE

North : Residential Plot of Yengkhom Shamu
South : Residential Plot of Amakham Meena
East : Residential Plot of Khangembam Kumar
West : Residential Plot of Khumanthem Tombi

**NB: The Plots/Road mentioned above indicates the boundaries of the containment zone and in no case are included within the containment zone.*

Further, the geographical area lying within a radius of 150 metre beyond the containment zone/area as per schedule aforementioned is identified as the **Buffer Zone** and the following measures are being adopted in order to effectively break the chain of transmission of the disease:

- 1) Extensive surveillance and contact tracing of the positive cases
- 2) Reporting clinically suspect cases on COVID-19 on real time basis
- 3) Clinical management of confirmed cases.
- 4) Sensitization of the local residents on personal hygiene, physical distancing and other preventive measures

Any person/institution/organization found violating any of the above mentioned measures shall be deemed to have committed an offence punishable under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.



- 13) Station Director, AIR/DDK, and Imphal to include the above orders in the local news bulletin.
- 14) News Editor, ISTV/IMPACT/TOM TV, Imphal to include the above in the news bulletin.
