CURFEW ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 Cr.P.C

(No. CS.3/2009/Pt-II/140, Dated, Shillong, the 19th April, 2020)

WHEREAS, in view of the prevailing situation concerning COVID -19 in the State, Country and Globally,

WHEREAS, to put in place preventive and mitigation measures to identify and take more stringent steps so the pandemic of COVID-19 is contained in Ri Bhoi District and Meghalaya, by way of ensuring observance of strict protocols of the Advisories issued by Government of Meghalaya in the Health & Family Welfare Department;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 144Cr.P.C and read with Regulation 3 of the Meghalaya Epidemic Disease, COVID – 19 Regulation, 2020, I Smti. R.M. Kurbah, IAS, District Magistrate, Ri Bhoi District, do hereby promulgate "CURFEW" within the jurisdiction of Ri Bhoi District with effect from 6:00 A.M of 20th April 2020 up to 6:00 A.M. of 26th April, 2020.

This Order will "NOT" apply to Security Forces, Medical Teams on Duty, Police and Armed Forces, Fire & Emergency Service, Wholesale and Retail Pharmacies, MeECL & Power Grid, Food and Civil Supply Department, FCI, Public Works Department (PWD), Public Health Engineering (PHE) Department, A.H.& Vety. Department, Postal Service, Telecom, Communication &IT services, Press, Print & Electronic Media, Banks, ATMs & Treasuries, Petrol pumps, Essential services including Health Services, Home Delivery of LPG Cylinders, Home Delivery of essential/household items, Online food delivery, Online Service delivery, Courier services, Authorized workshops and designated spare parts dealerships of Health and Family Welfare Department, Govt. of Meghalaya and Government Officials on Duty.

These services shall strictly comply with all protocols and procedures including social distancing, disinfection and other advisories of Government in the Health Department, "WITHOUT FAIL".

Also, movement of vehicles carrying Essential Commodities, Security Forces, Medical Equipments & Goods vehicles are also exempted. However, Drivers and attendants of the vehicles shall be subject to medical screening as per laid down protocols.

Curfew passes to be obtained via online application @www.ribhoi.gov.in.

This order will not affect the arrangement of Fair Price Shops, Identified Wholesale Traders and Identified Local Retailers which shall open as per schedule released from time to time.

In view of the urgency of the matter this order is passed ex-parte.
