CURFEW ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 CrP.C.

(No. DCRB(CN)/COVID-19/1/2020/ 309, Dated, Nongpoh the 30th May, 2020.)

Whereas, in view of the prevailing situation concerning COVID-19 in the country and globally;

Whereas, to put in place preventive measures and mitigation measures to identify and take more stringent steps so the pandemic of COVID-19 is contained, reduced and eliminated in Ri Bhoi District and Meghalaya, by way of ensuring observance of strict protocols of the Advisories issued by Government of Meghalaya in the Health & Family Welfare Department;

Now, therefore, I Smti. R. M. Kurbah, IAS, District Magistrate, Ri Bhoi District, Nongpoh, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 144 Cr.P.C. read together with Regulation 3 of the Meghalaya Epidemic Diseases, COVID-19 Regulations, 2020 and Guidelines No.5 (i) of Order Dated 1st May, 2020 of Government of India in the Ministry of Home Affairs do hereby promulgate **NIGHT CURFEW** in Ri Bhoi District with effect from **1st June, 2020 (Monday) up to 8th June, 2020 (Monday) only for timings falling between 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM each day.**

This Order will **Not** apply to: -

1. Security Forces
2. Medical Teams on Duty
3. Wholesale & Retail Pharmacies
4. Police and Armed Forces
5. Fire & Emergency Services
6. MeECL, NEEPCO & Power Grid
7. Food & Civil Supply Department
8. Food Corporation of India (FCI)
9. Public Works Department (PWD)
10. Public Health Engineering (PHE) Department
11. A.H & Vety. Department
12. Postal Service, Telecom, Communications & IT Services
13. Press, Print & Electronic Media
14. Banks, ATM & Treasuries
15. Petrol Pumps
16. Essential Services including Health Services and online food delivery.
17. Authorized workshops and designated spare parts dealerships of Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of Meghalaya.
18. Government Officials on Duty.

These services shall strictly comply with all protocols and procedures including social distancing, limiting of field staff to the barest minimum and other advisories of Government in the Health & Family Welfare Department, **WITHOUT FAIL.**

Private and Public vehicle shall ply on rotation basis as per the following arrangement:

Days	Transport Vehicles	Non Transport Vehicles
Monday, Wednesday & Friday	Yellow Passes	Number Ending With No. 0,2,4,6 & 8
Tuesday, Thursday & Saturday	Pink Passes	Number Ending With No. 1,3,5,7 & 9
Sunday	No Transport & Non Transport Vehicle Will Be Allow To Ply On The Road	

The vehicles are to strictly utilized only 50% seating capacity, small 4 (four) wheelers to ply with 2 (Two) passengers and drive and for two wheelers pillion rider is not allowed. The driver and passenger are to strictly ensure social distancing wearing of mask at all times, use of gloves, hand sanitizers and to strictly follow all other advisories of health & family Welfare Department.


Violation of any norms and advisories of the Government in the Health & Family Welfare Department and this Office will be liable to action as per the Law.

Movement of vehicles carrying essential goods, security forces, medical equipments and shops for repair of trucks on highways is allowed. However, Drivers and attendants of the vehicles shall be subject to medical screening as per laid down protocols.

Curfew passes for timings falling between 7:00 PM to 6:00 AM with effect from 1st June, 2020 (Monday) up to 8th June, 2020 (Monday) to be obtained via online application @ www.ribhoi.gov.in

In view of the urgency of the matter, this Order has been made ex parte.
