CURFEW ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 Cr.P.C.

(No. DCRB(CN)/COVID-19/1/2020/Pt.I/78, Dated, Nongpoh the 30th October, 2020)

Whereas, in view of the prevailing situation concerning COVID-19 in the country and globally;

Whereas, to put in place preventive measures and mitigation measures to identify and take more stringent steps so the pandemic of COVID-19 is contained, reduced and eliminated in Ri Bhoi District and Meghalaya, by way of ensuring observance of strict protocols of the Advisories issued by Government of Meghalaya in the Health & Family Welfare Department.

Now, therefore, I Smti. R. M. Kurbah, IAS, District Magistrate, Ri Bhoi District, Nongpoh, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 144 Cr.P.C. read together with Regulation 3 of the Meghalaya Epidemic Diseases, COVID-19 Regulations, 2020 and Guidelines No.5 (i) of Order Dated 1st May, 2020 of Government of India in the Ministry of Home Affairs do hereby promulgate **NIGHT CURFEW** in Ri Bhoi District **with effect from 1st November, 2020 (Sunday) up to 15th November, 2020 (Sunday) only for timings falling between 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM each day.**

This Order will **NOT** apply to: -

1. Police, Armed and Security Forces
2. Medical Teams on Duty.
3. Wholesale & Retail Pharmacies.
4. Fire & Emergency Services
5. MeECL, NEEPCO & Power Grid
6. Food & Civil Supplies Department
7. Food Corporation of India (FCI) vehicles
8. Officer and Staff of Corona Care Centres
9. Information and Public Relation Department
10. National Highways & Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd(NHIDCL)
11. Shillong Municipal Board
12. Telecom Service.

These services shall strictly comply with all protocols and procedures including social distancing, limiting of field staff to the barest minimum and other advisories of Government in the Health & Family Welfare Department, **WITHOUT FAIL.**

Also, movements of vehicles carrying essential goods, security forces, medical equipments and shops for repair of trucks on highways are exempted. However, Drivers and attendants of the vehicles shall be subject to medical screening as per laid down protocols.

However, Exemption granted to Official and Non- Officer emergency/essential services establishments and agencies above shall not extend to Containment Areas

Curfew passes for timings falling between 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM with effect from **1st November, 2020 (Sunday) up to 15th November, 2020 (Sunday) only for timings falling between 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM each day** to be obtained via online application @ www.ribhoi.gov.in

In view of the urgency of the matter, this Order has been made ex parte.
