**ORDER**

In In pursuance to the Order of the Governemnt of Meghalaya, Home (Political) Department, vide No. POL.75/2020/Pt.I/109, Dated Shillong the 13<sup>th</sup> August, 2021 regarding resumption of 30% of Commercial transportation and to ensure uniformity in the plying of vehicles (public transport) across the District, which also includes inter-district movement, the following arrangement of Vehicles is made:

Further, In pursuance to the Hon'ble High Court order PILNo. 6/2021, dt.23.06.2021 All Drivers of local taxis/auto-rickshaws/maxi cabs and buses under Ri Bhoi District should display their vaccination status at the front windshield(Left Hand Side) of their vehicles.

1. Vaccinated drivers should report to the office of the District Transport Officer, Ri Bhoi District Nongpoh along with their Vaccination Certificate and Driving License for collection of Vaccinated Stickers/Green Card. The representative of the Commercial vehicles Associations should collect the above documents on behalf of the drivers and submit the same to the office of the the District Transport Officer, Ri Bhoi District, Nongpoh
2. Non-vaccinated driver should crealy display their vaccination status as '**NOT -VACCINATED**' at the front windshield(Left Hand Side) of their vehicles. **AS SELF DECLARATION IN PLAIN PAPER(A4 Size)**, for which they will make their own arrangement.
3. Non-vaccinated drivers are required to get tested and produce a Negative RT-PCR report every 10(ten) days which shall be shown to the competent authority on demand.
4. The vaccination status as mention in para 1,2 and 3 are mandaroty and in the absence of which the drivers will not be allowed to ply the vehicles.
5. All commercial vehicles drivers who are willing to ger themselves vaccinated may report to the designated vaccination centre along with their EPIC and then collect their sticker /green card from the office of the District Transport Officer, Ri Bhoi District, Nongpoh.
6. Plying to other neighbouring Districts would strictly require passes from the concerned District Authorities.

All drivers, conductors, helpers and passenger are to strictly ensure social distancing, wearing of mask at all times, hand sanitizers and to strictly follow all other advisories of health & family Welfare Department.

Violation of any norms and advisories of the Government in the Health & Family Welfare Department and this Office will be liable to action as per the Law.
