**FORM OF PRELIMINARY NOTIFICATION TO BE ISSUED BY THE COLLECTOR UNDER
SUBSECTION (1) OF SECTION 11**

WHEREAS, the Government of Kerala have as per Notification No.Vol. IV No.2753 SRO. 835/2015 dated 09.12.2015 appointed the Special Tahsildar, LA (General), Alappuzha / Pala to perform the functions of a collector for the pupose of land acquisition under the Right to Fair Compensation and Transperancy in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013.

AND WHEREAS, the Government here by appoint Deputy Collector (LA), Collectorate, Alappuzha as the Administrator for the purpose of Rehabilitation and Resettlement to the proposed acquisition.

AND WHEREAS, it appears to the Government that the land specified in the schedule below is needed or is likely to be needed for public purpose to wit for the construction of approach road to Makkekadavu-Nerekadavu bridge

Now, THEREFORE, notice is hereby given to that effect to whomsoever it may concern, in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (1) of section 11 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transperancy in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013.

All persons interested in the said land are accordingly required to lodge before the Special Tahsildar, LA (General), Alappuzha in the case of land in Thycattussery village and Special Tahsildar, LA (General), Pala in the case of land in Vadakkemuri village within 15 days from the date of publication of the above notification, or after giving public notice regarding this whichever is later, a statement in writing of their objections, if any, regarding the updation of land records or title in respect of the land proposed for acquisition. Any objections / statement which is received after the due date or which does not clearly explain as to how the objector is interested in the land is liable to be summarily rejected.

SUMMARY OF SOCIAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT STUDY REPORT

The Land is to be acquired for approach road to Makkekadavu-Nerekadavu bridge, that is constructing across the Vembanattu lake for connecting between Alappuzha and Kottayam districts as a part of Thuravoor-Pampa road. This road will be very access to the people of both side of the districts. There is no considerable alternative alignments. Social Impact Assessment agency unanimously reaches the conclusion that the social and economic benefits of the project outweighs its negative impacts if proper mitigation plans as outlined in the report. Thus the agency recommended to go forward with the land acquisition procedures as per the current plan.
